





Process of the Practice	This is a regular practice of the department. Every year the department collects water samples from farmers. The samples are analysed for its different parameters such as pH, conductivity, hardness, bicarbonates, chlorides.
Impact of the Practice	 This practice, in the first place, literates farmers in water contents. They apply those fertilizers for farming which suites the water quality. It develops research attitude among students and also helps them at seeking jobs after graduation.
Evidence of Success	 The farmers benefited by this practice apply knowledge sought from the department. Every year the beneficiaries of this practice have been increased. Alumni of the department are working in different industries. Their experience at this practice has helped them at the point of entry in service and also they apply this knowledge in their work.
