Annual Report of Excursion 2019-2020

As a part of Syllabus prescribed by the Board of Studies in Zoology, Shivaji University, Kolhapur the department of Zoology had organized excursion for the B.Sc. - I, II, III classes.

For this academic year for B.Sc. - I a total of 41 students participated in the tour which was scheduled at Kolhapur, Ganpatipule, and Ratnagiri & Pawas on 17 and 18 February 2020. The tour was guided by Dr. T. S. Bhosale, Mr. A.B. Mane & Shri. U H Magare. During the tour students visited the Museum at New Palace Kolhapur where Stuffed fauna and alive wild species were shown and information about their Habit and Habitat was provided to the students. At Ratnagiri and Ganpatipule we visited to sandy shore, rocky shore and muddy shore and studied various fauna and faunal adaptations. We visited Marine Biology Research Centre at Ratnagiri where the students noted various species of ornamental aquarium fishes. The skeleton of whale fish is maintained in good condition in M.B.R.C.

For B.Sc.II students, the tour was organized to Radhanagiri Wild Life Sanctuary, Malvan, Sindhudurg and Kunkeshwar on 23 and 24 January 2020. Total 40 students were participated in this tour.
