



The poem is highly symbolical and hence opts for multiple interpretations multiple interpretation. In the light of Post Modernist theory, it is really a reader's text which gets meaning as per the interpretation done by the reader. The principles; nothing exists outside the text and meaning is nothing but play of mind on arbitrary signs in the system of language are perfectly applicable to the poem. Since its publication in 1922, the poem is variously interpreted as an ambivalence of mind, meditation on death, conflict between individual desires and social restrictions, conflict between responsibility and attraction and so on. However the present paper tries to study the poem in the light of Freud's concept of mind and its working on three levels; id, ego and superego. The first stanza of the poem is the manifestation of the working of id; the primitive part of mind. The second stanza stands for conscience which follows all the moral and social rules and is controlled by superego. The final stanza stands for the rational and pragmatic choice made by the ego which works as the balancing factor between extreme primitivism of id and extreme conscience of superego.

The choice we make in such situation works as mediator between two overarching behavioral tendencies: our biological aggressive and pleasure-seeking drives versus our socialized internal control over those drives. The present paper studies the conflict between attraction and responsibility as conflict between id and superego and the final choice emphasizing strong and emphatic ego.

The speaker finds the woods very alluring, drawn both to their darkness and depth. The speaker knows the owner of the woods; however he is sure that he will not see him. The owner's home is far away in the village, and thus he is physically incapable of seeing the speaker pause to watch the snow fall in the forest. The id is attracted towards woods, at the same times wants to confirm that nobody knows this. The speaker thinks his or her horse must find it strange to stop there on the darkest evening of the year. "My little horse" (84) stands as the symbol of superego,

conscience, and moral compass. It thinks it queer to enjoy the possessions of other. So the mind faces the question, "Is there some mistake?" (84) They are surrounded only by the forest and a frozen lake. Speaker's ego is so strong that he never forgets his obligations to fulfill.

Thus, though he or she would like to stay and rest, the speaker has many promises to keep and many more miles to go before he reaches his final destination. The natural world, the primitive instincts are "lovely" and overwhelming. It tempts the speaker to linger in the dark and cold suggests that nature is both a tempting and a threatening force. However moral compass is stronger than the natural force. It makes the speaker do the right choice.

The line, "Whose woods these are I think I know" (84) shows the possessiveness of the speaker. It is clear that there's no one there to actually stop the speaker from trespassing. The owner's "house is in the village," meaning "he will not see" the speaker(84). While this owner may think the woods belong to him, the speaker is standing there to watch his woods "fill[ing] up with snow" (84) in the land owner's absence. Primitive impulse of owning other's possessions is underlined. The speaker begins by wondering "whose woods" he is passing through. This demonstrates a concern with ownership and legal rights to land: the woods are not merely the woods but someone's woods. It focuses a special significance of ownership in the speaker's world and also emphasizes the trespassing in other's territory. However the conscience of the poet does not allow him to linger and forces to choose the path of duty to fulfill his promises.

Though the speaker is drawn to the woods as the poem subtly suggests, would like to stay there longer to simply watch the falling snow. However various responsibilities prevent his lingering anymore. The speaker is caught in ambivalence to choose between duty to others and those irritating "promises to keep" (84) and his or her wish to stay in the dark and lovely woods. The poem can thus be read as reflection on a broader conflict between moral obligations and individual's desires. This tension between responsibility and desire is clearest in the final stanza. Although "the woods are lovely," (84) the speaker has other important things to attend. It is very unusual that the speaker has stopped to gaze at someone else's forest filling with snow. Indeed, the fact that the speaker's horse which is suggestive of conscience "thinks it queer"—even a "mistake". It implies that speaker's world is guided by clear conscience. He is not the person who will be tempted by attractions. However much the speaker might like to stay in the "dark and deep" (84) woods, then, he or she must continue on. He gives priority to promises. It happens

more out of moral obligation than social ones. In the absence of social forces in the darkest evening of night, the strong conscience and ego help the speaker to follow his promises.

Throughout the poem, the speaker seems to be stuck in ambivalence between moral obligations and nature's lovely, dark and deep attraction. Though the speaker reflects on the possibilities offered by each, he is bound by the restrictions of conscience. Moral and societal obligations restrict speaker's free will. The compelling pulls of responsibility dominate the individual's desire. Thus study of the poem in the light of Freud's concept of mind and its working on three levels; id, ego and superego shows. The first stanza of the poem is the manifestation of the working of id; the primitive part of mind. The second stanza stands for conscience which follows all the moral and social rules and is controlled by superego. The final stanza stands for the rational and pragmatic choice made by the ego which works as the balancing factor between extreme primitivism of id and extreme conscience of superego.

Woods are lovely, dark and deep

But I have promises to keep

And miles to go before I sleep

And miles to go before I sleep(84)

Finally speaker confesses that the woods are lovely, dark and deep and he is attracted towards wood. However he chooses the path of responsibility than temporal attraction. He is sure that this path will lead him to his final destination, "And miles to go before I sleep" (84)

In contrast to the instinctual id and the moral superego, the *ego* is the rational, pragmatic part of our personality. It is less primitive than the id and is partly conscious and partly unconscious. It's what Freud considered to be the "self," and its job is to balance the demands of the id and superego in the practical context of reality. Your ego would mediate the conflict between your id ("I want to watch the woods filling up with snow") and superego ("Is there some mistake") and decides to go miles and mile before I sleep. While this may mean you have to give priority to responsibilities, which would frustrate your id. your ego decides to make that sacrifice as part of the compromise. This choice satisfies the moral drive of the speaker also avoiding an unpleasant social situation and potential feelings of shame.

Nation as Disintegrated and Confused Place in Saadat Hasan Manto's 'Toba Tek Singh'

Abstract

Notion of place and nation is always connected to the identity of the person. Home is a place to which a lot of warm sentiments are attached. Home is a place to which a lot of warm sentiments are attached. Home is a kind of fixed placewhere one finds warmth, love, security and sense of belongingness. However partition has changed the concept of home and belonging foe the people who were strongly rooted in the soil of mother-land. The exile because of partition due to decisions taken by policy makers is beyond the imagination of millions of common people on both the sides. It is forced exile which causes not only the loss of geographical places but of psychological space. It affects the sensibility of exiled to fill him with the sense of not belonging. Saadat Hasan Manto's story 'Toba Tek Singh' depicts the disintegration and confusion about the notion of nation and place in the time of partition period through the mentality of lunatics. The story underlines what lunatics can understand is not perceived by the wise policy makers. The present paper tries to focus on the disintegration and confusion of notion of nation on the background of partition.

Notion of place and nation is always connected to the identity of the person. Home is a place to which a lot of warm sentiments are attached. Home is a place to which a lot of warm sentiments are attached. Home is a kind of fixed placewhere one finds warmth, love, security and sense of belongingness. However partition has changed the concept of home and belonging foe the people who were strongly rooted in the soil of motherland. The exile because of partition due to decisions taken by policy makers is beyond the imagination of millions of common people on both the sides. It is forced

exile which causes not only the loss of geographical places but of psychological space. It affects the sensibility of exiled to fill him with the sense of not belonging. Saadat Hasan Manto's story 'Toba Tek Singh' depicts the disintegration and confusion about the notion of nation and place in the time of partition period through the mentality of lunatics. The story underlines what lunatics can understand is not perceived by the wise policy makers.

After three tiers of partition, it was decided to exchange the lunatics. The muslim lunatics will be sent to pakistan and Hindu lunatics to Hindustani asylums. Lunatics even don't have idea what is Hindustan and what is Pakistan. One of muslim lunatics asks his friend, "Maulavi Sahab, what is this Pakistan?". He answered, "It is a place in Hindustan where they make cut throat razors." Sikh lunatic asked another Sikh, "Sardarji, why are you being sent to Hindustan?" (p.37) Through the overheard discussions of officials they knew only one thing that there was a man named Mahammad Ali Jinnah whom people called Quad-e-azam, the leader. He had created new land for muslims called Pakistan.

There was a Sikh named Bishen Singh in the asylum who had been there for the past fifteen years. He was a landlord from the place called Toba Tek Singh. He was very keen about listening discussions in the asylum about Hindustan, Pakistan and exchange of lunatics. He began to ask other lunatics where Toba Tek Singh, the place he came from was. But nobody knew whether it was in Pakistan or Hindustan. They were confused how the places in Hindustan turned into places in Pakistan overnight.

The procedure of exchange of lunatics was really ridiculous and meaningless. It was really ridiculous that what lunatics could understand was not being understood by wise people. For lunatics Hindustan and Pakistan were imaginary places. At the time of exchange Bishen Singh's turn came and the concerned officials on the other side of the border began to enter his name in the register he asked, "Where is Toba Tek Singh?...in Pakistan or Hindustan?" Toba Tek Singh has become metaphor for the utter absurdity and mindlessness of process

of partition. Lunatics are disturbed by the idea of partition and feeling of loss and notbelonging. They don't want to go either in Pakistan or Hindustan. One of the lunatics declares, "I'd rather live on this tree"

The story of *Toba Tek Singh* is the story of place and feeling of uprootedness. The security attached to the notion of place is very important. Getting exiled from the land of origin is a deep and unbearable trauma for Bishen Singh . For him place is as important as his existence and identity. It is a part of his whole being and consciousness. How can he be separated and exiled from it? He has, as if, become one with the place. So in the end Bishen Singh declares, "Toba Tek Singh is here!" and falls down dead. It emphasizes the importance of place and home in human being's life. It is the story of exile, forced exile due to partition. Though Bishen Sigh is lunatic, he had not lost the sense of place and belongingness.

Belongingness to the place and location is very important aspect of existence and identity. Place is where you live and grow. Ifuprooted, itcreates the sense of nowhereness, the state of suspension like trishanku, neither here nor there. Hanging in between makes people rootless and sans identity. Insuch circumstances just imagination of displacement creates tension among the lunatics in asylum. It is not just physical displacement but mental displacement which confuses them about what is Pakistan and what is Hindustan. Before partition Hindustan was the dwelling place of their families and ancestors. It was not just the physical or geographical territory but it is a need for belonging to an identity rooted in the land of origin. The idea of separation from home and homeland is unbearable to the lunatics from both the side. So the actual process of exchange of lunatics become very complicated and tough for the officials on the both the sides. The end of the story highlights how badly the lives are affected by the decision of partition.

Exchange was finalised and lunatics only knew that the new place is unknown and dangerous. Once they lived peacefully. They don't want to lose the warmth and comfort of the place of origin. Bishen Singh is the representative of the love for place of origin. When the time of handover comes, he refuses to move an inch from the spot on which he is standing like a solid rock. He gives up his life on the border of no man's land dividing the two countries.
