























From feedback the conclusions are: The all respondents are satisfied with their general communication skills developing practical solutions to work place problems. About 83% of respondents are happy with Working as a part of a team and creative in response to workplace challenges. Mora than 64 % of respondents are happy with Their planning and organization skills, Self-motivated and taking on appropriate level of responsibility, Open to new idea and learning new techniques, Using technology and workplace equipment.

About 90% and 80% of respondents are satisfied with Ability to contribute to the goal of the organization and technical knowledge/skill. More than 96% of respondents are satisfied with Ability manage/leadership qualities, Innovativeness, creativity, Relationship with seniors/peers/subordinates. The respondents are happy for their Involvement in social activity with 86%, for Ability to take up extra responsibility with 77%, for Obligation to work beyond schedule if required with 77%.
