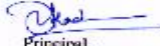

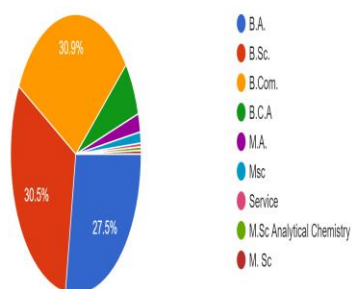

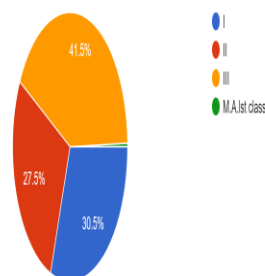
 Respondent Profile

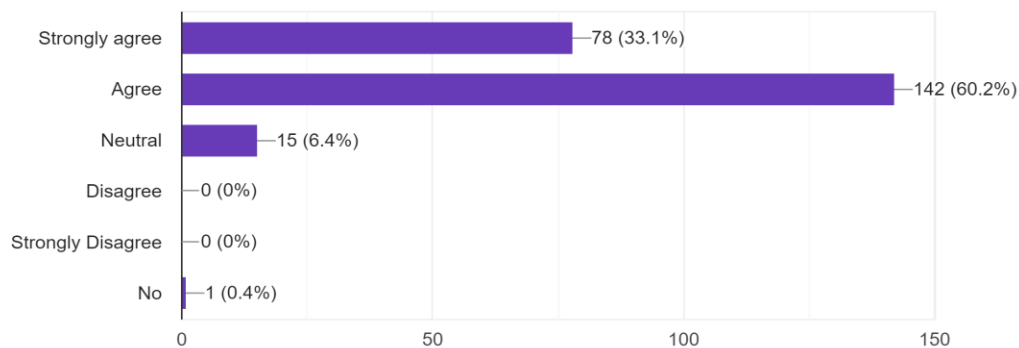

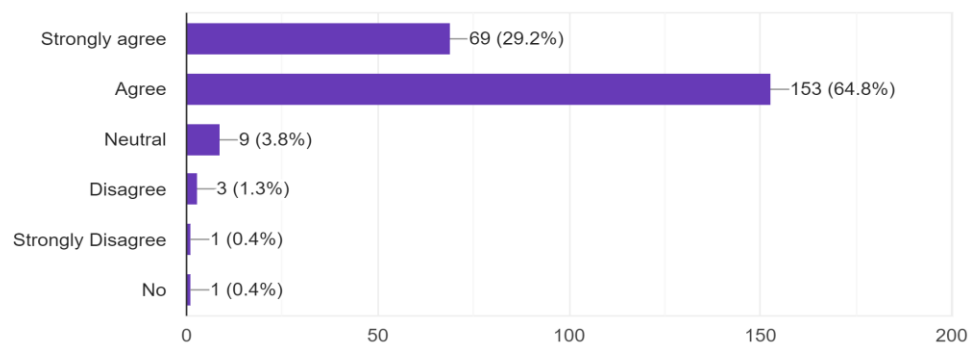

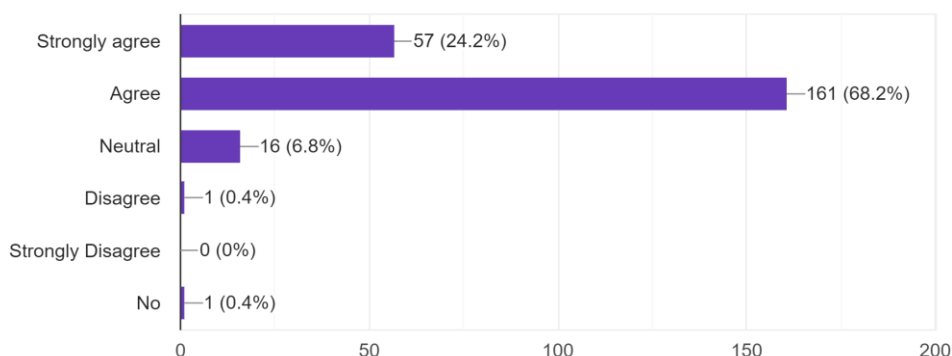

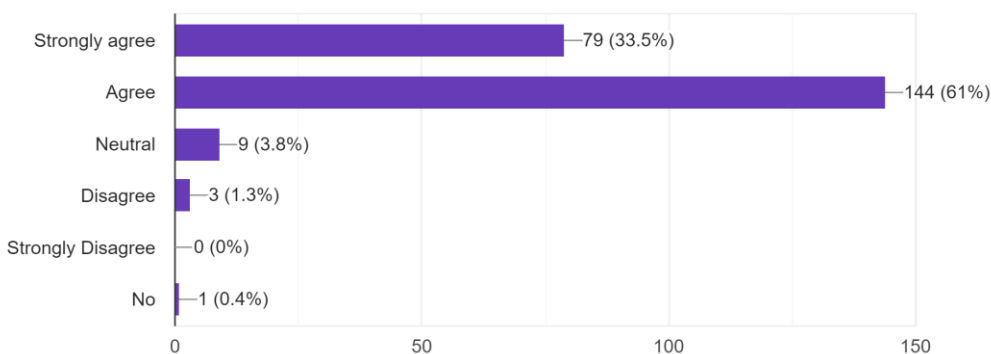

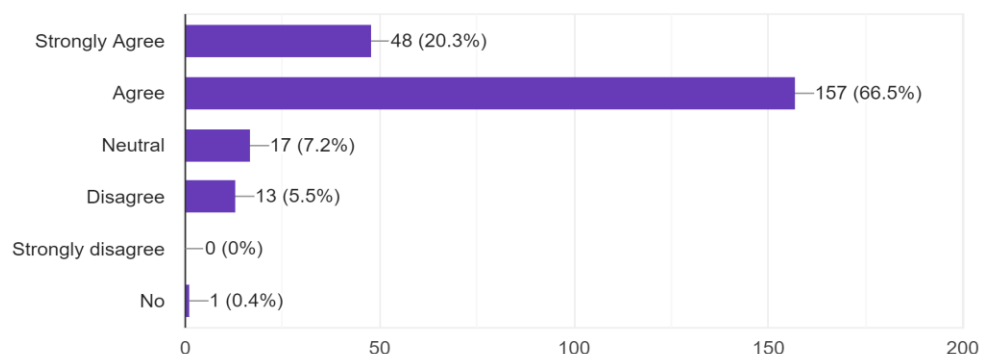

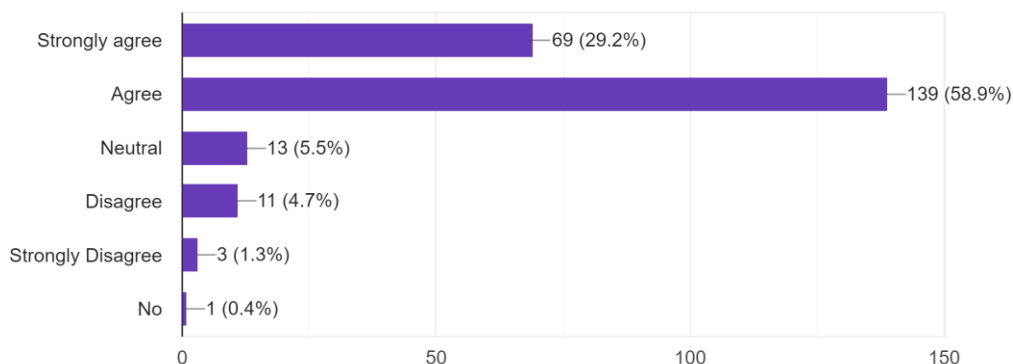

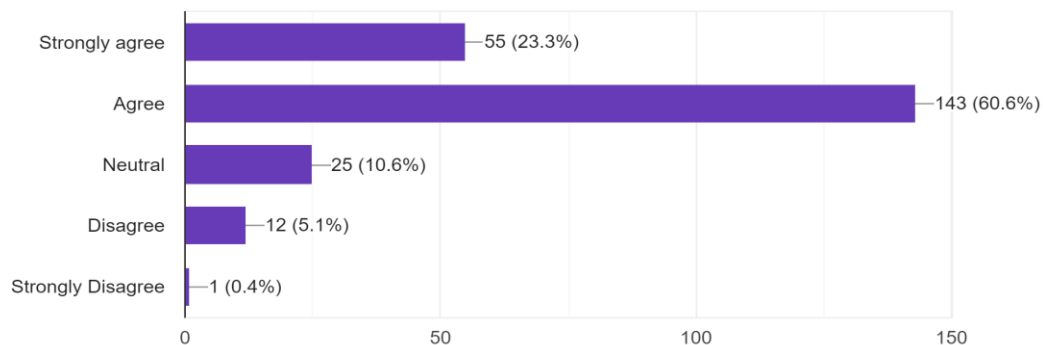

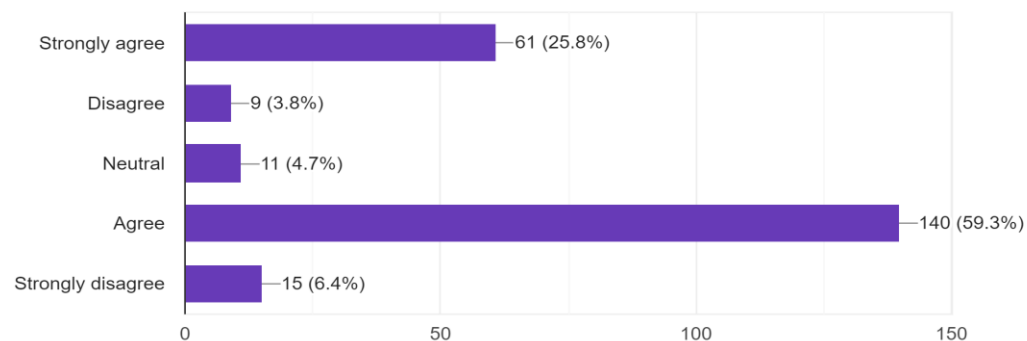

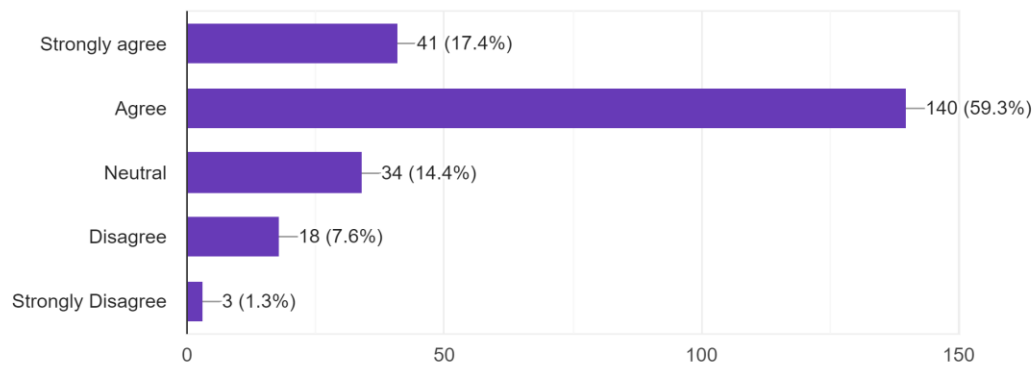

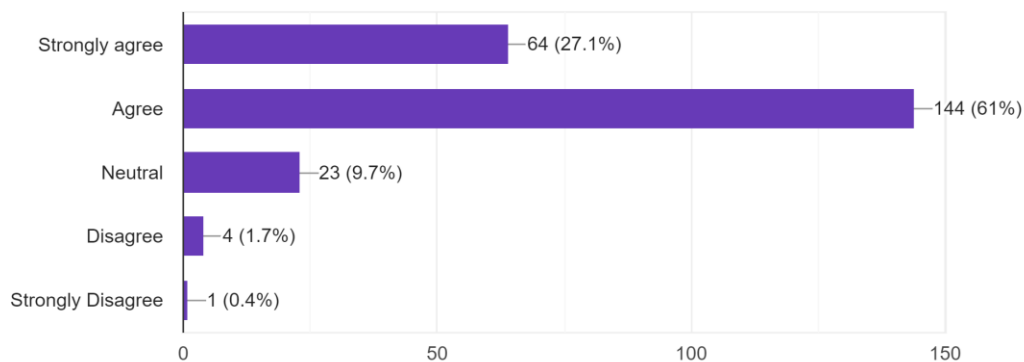

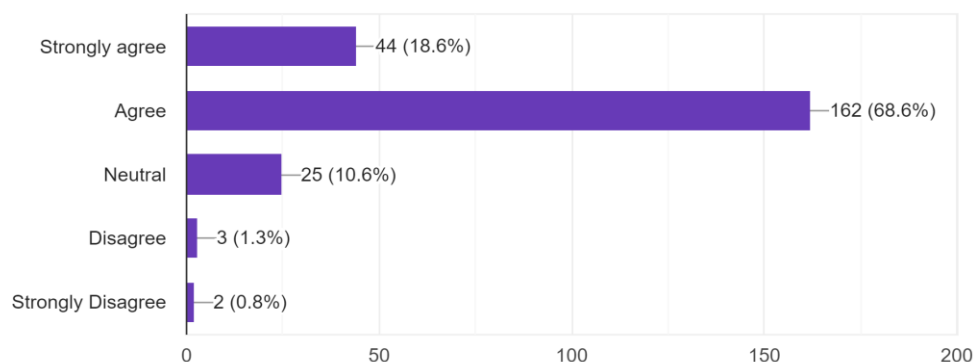

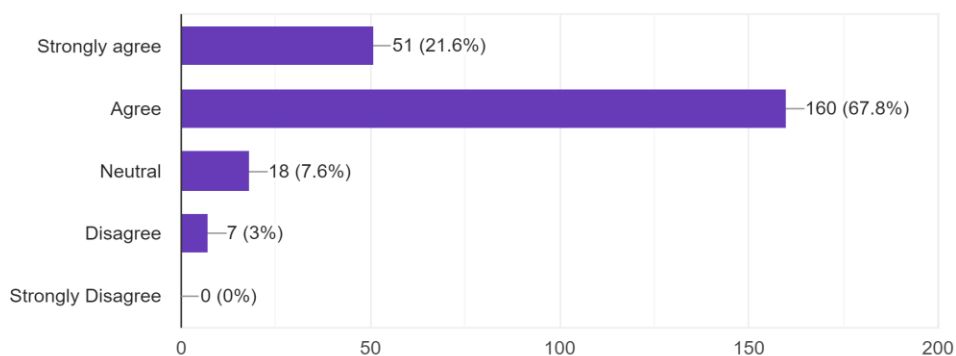

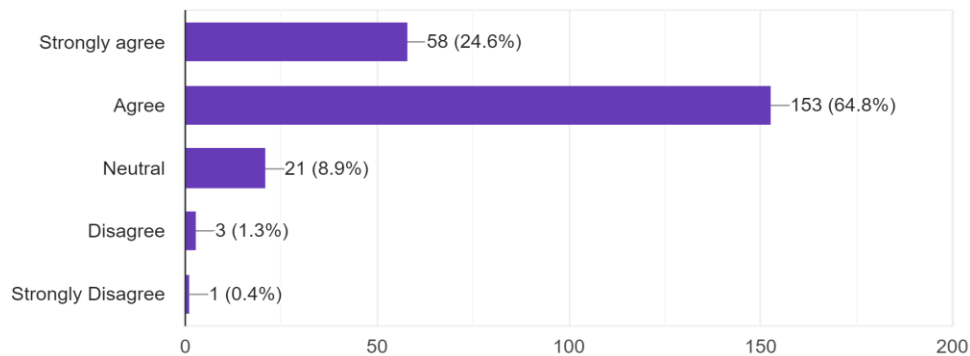

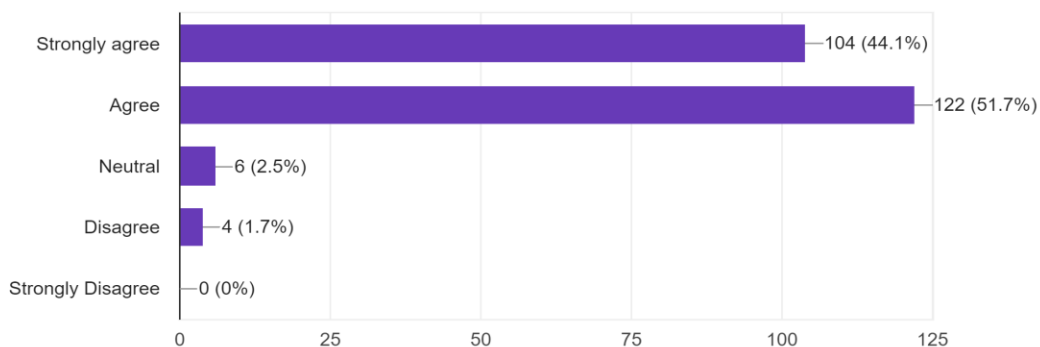

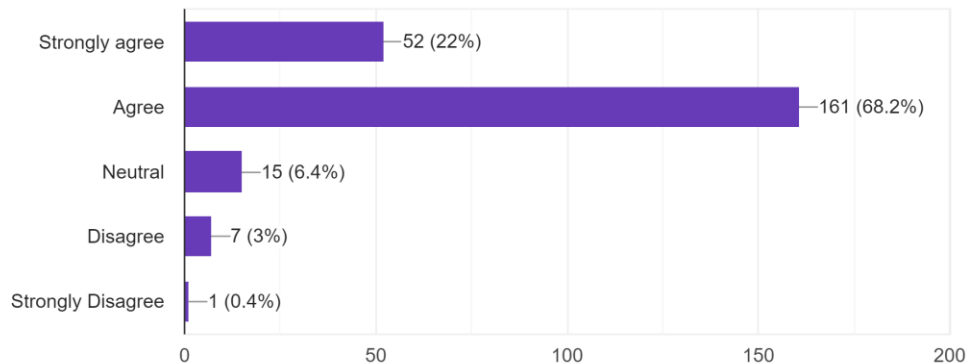

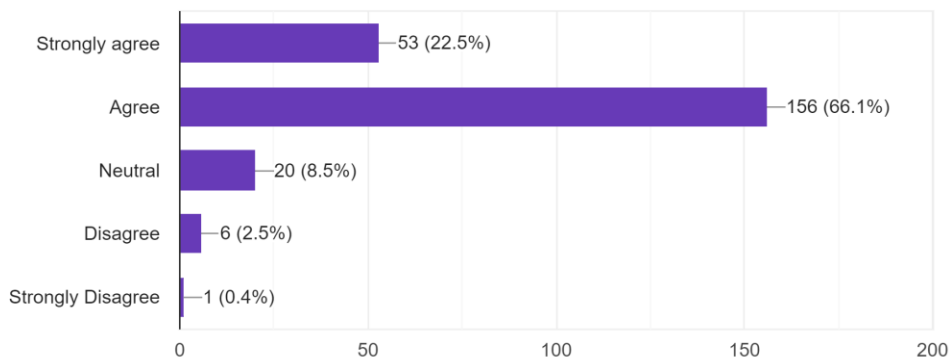

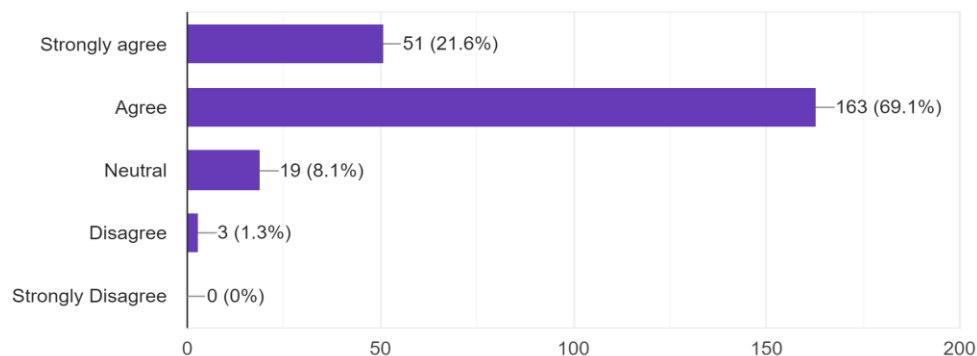

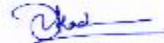

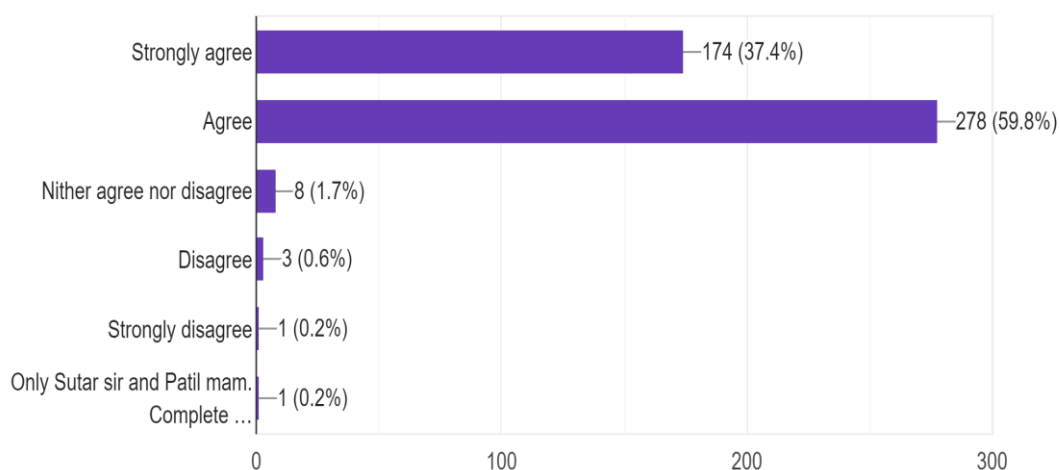

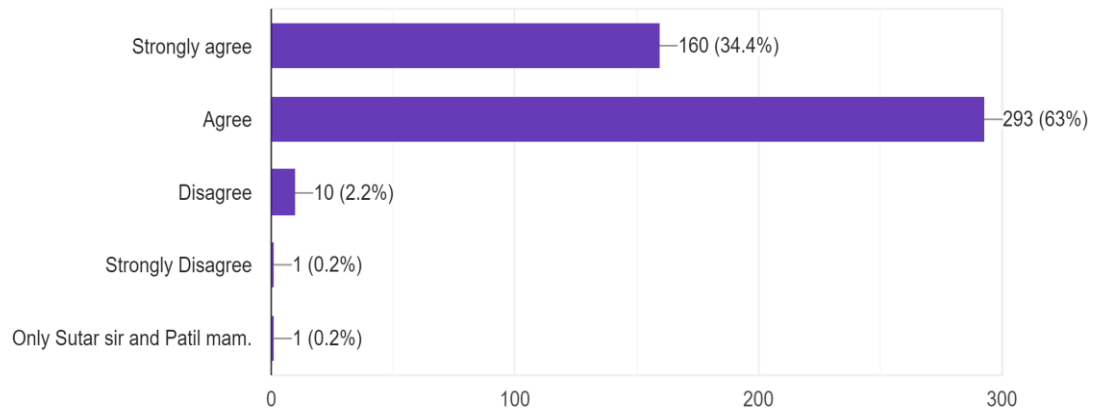

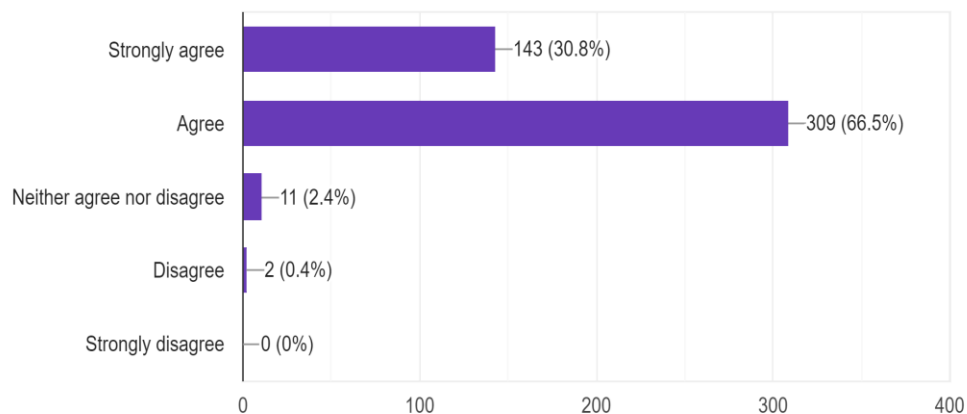

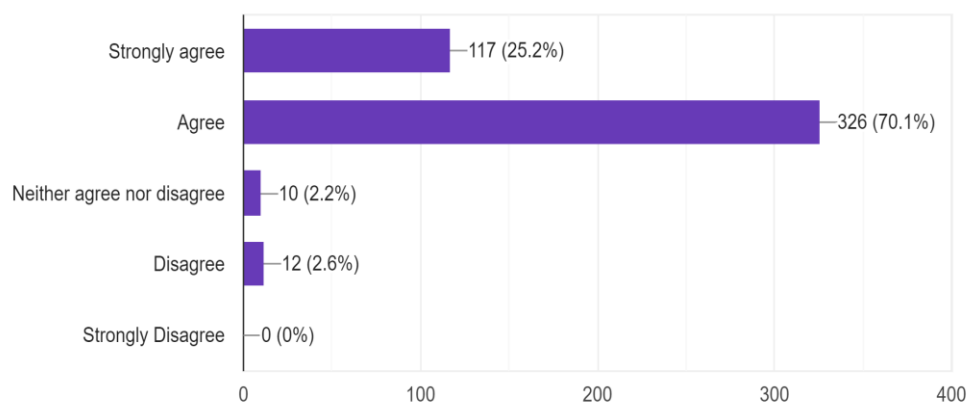

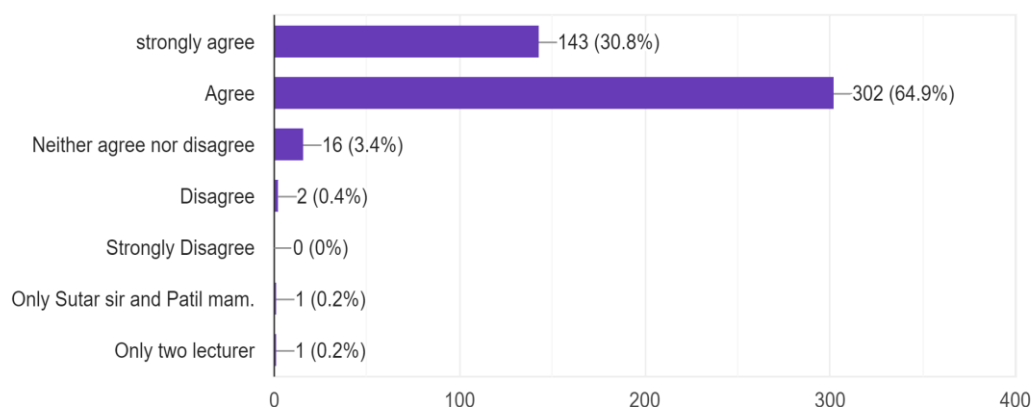

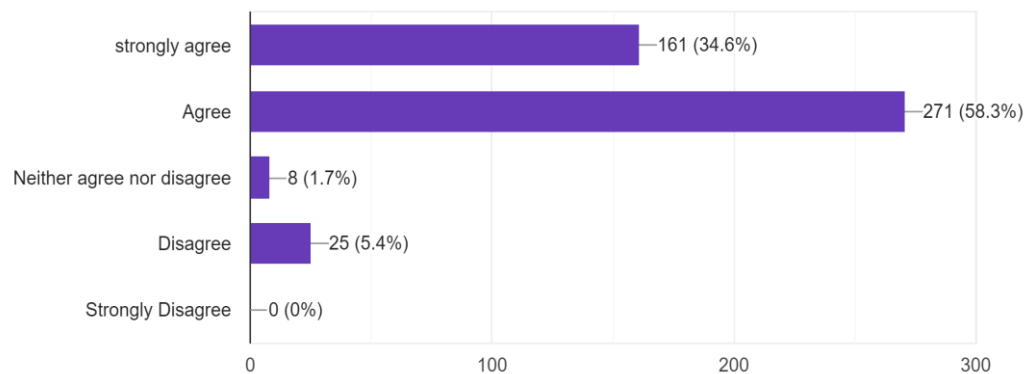

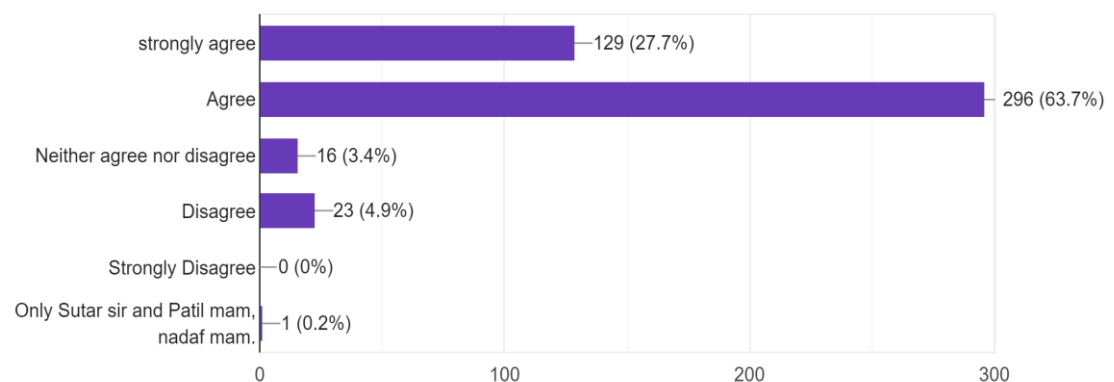

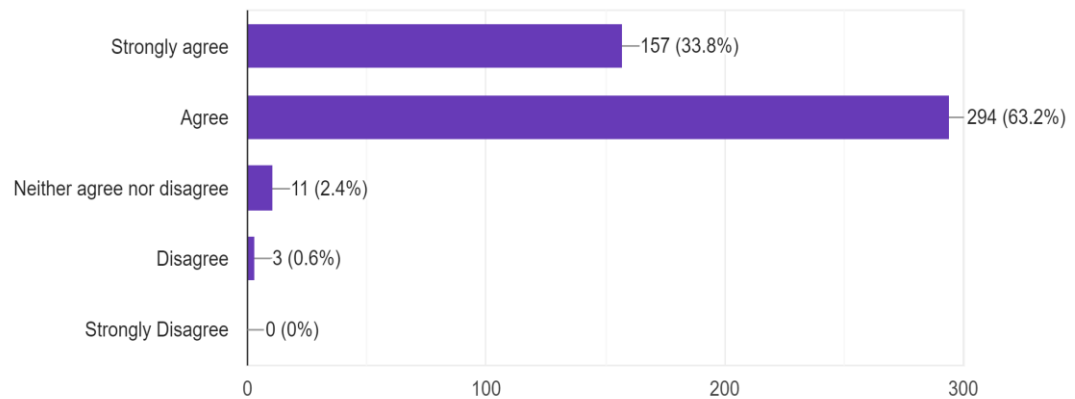

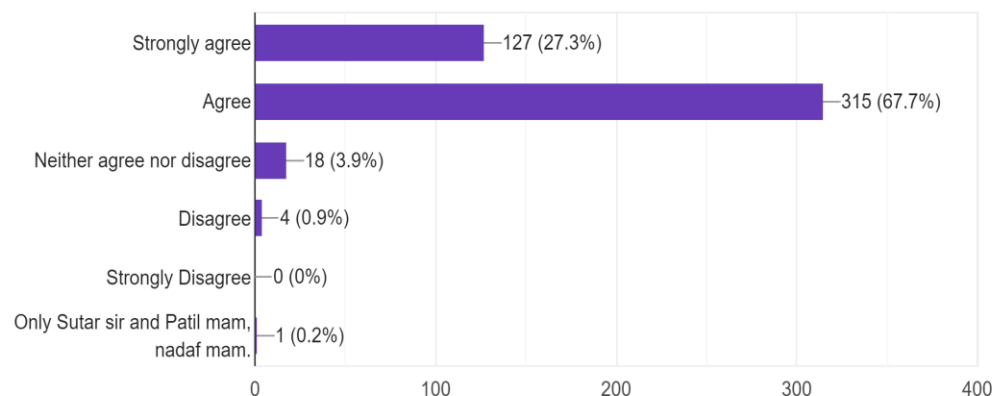

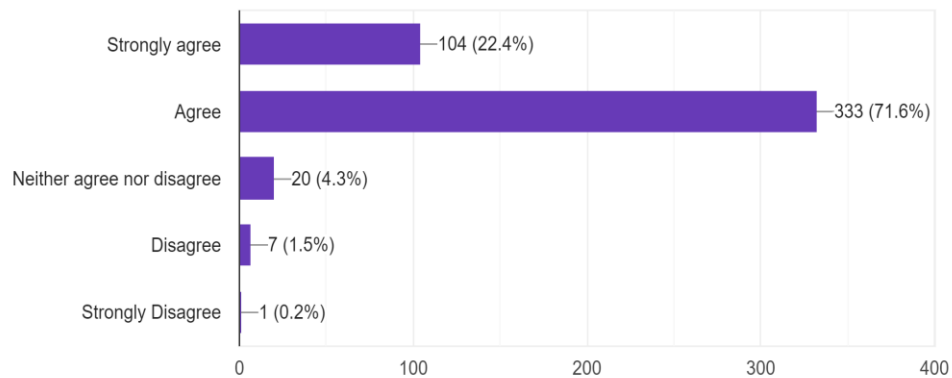

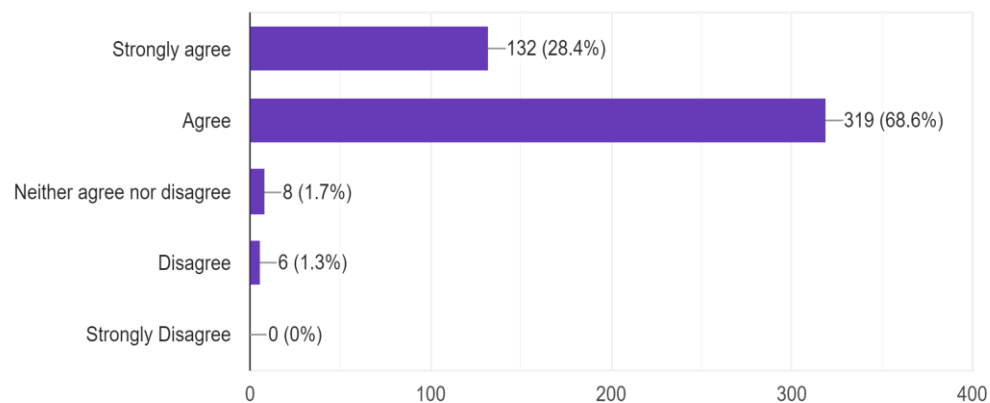

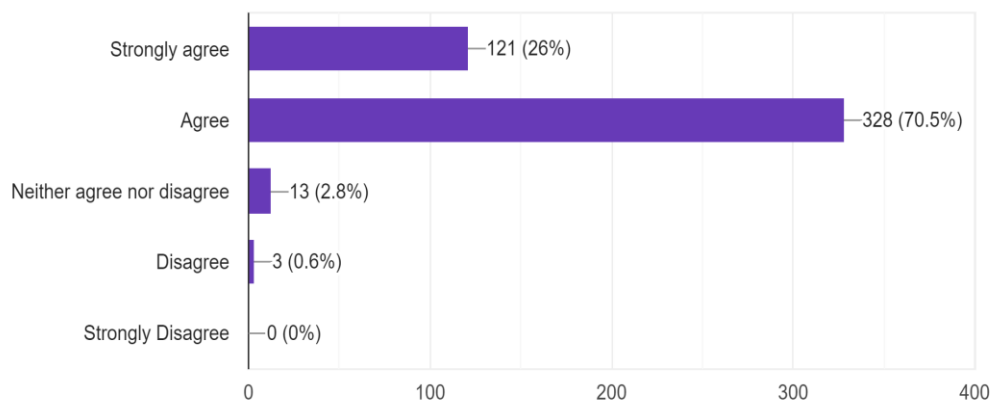

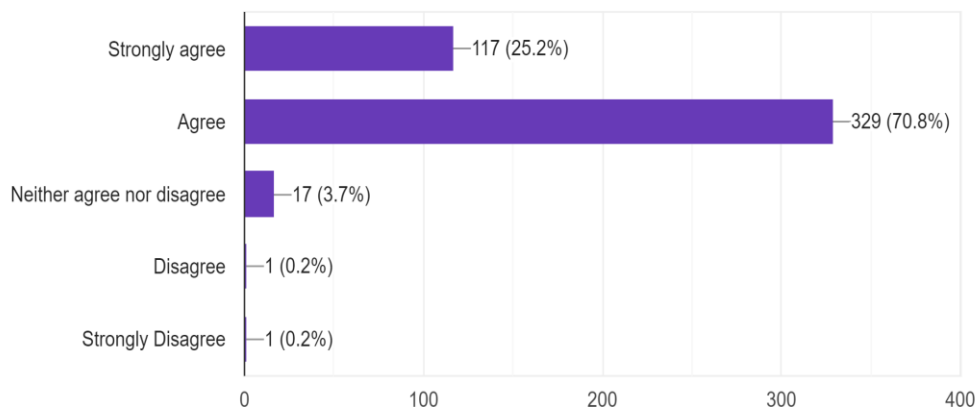

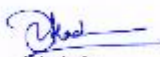

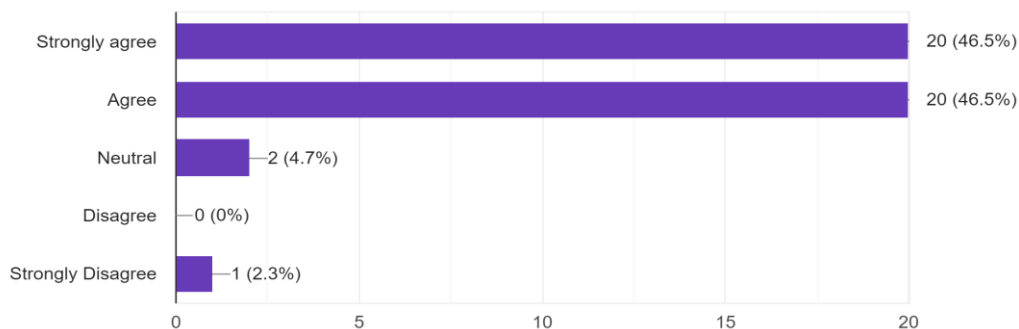

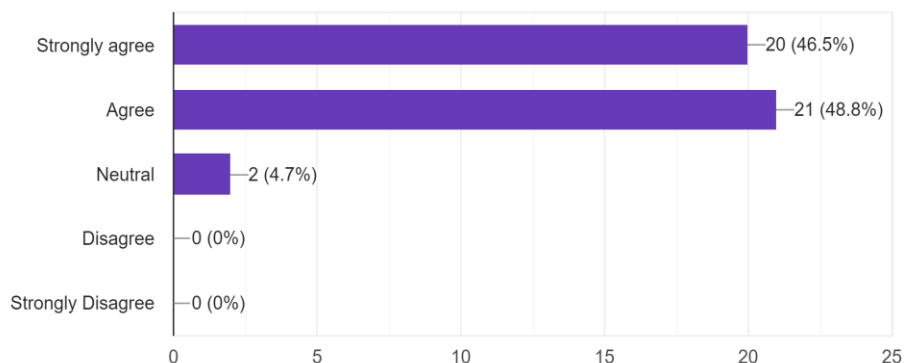

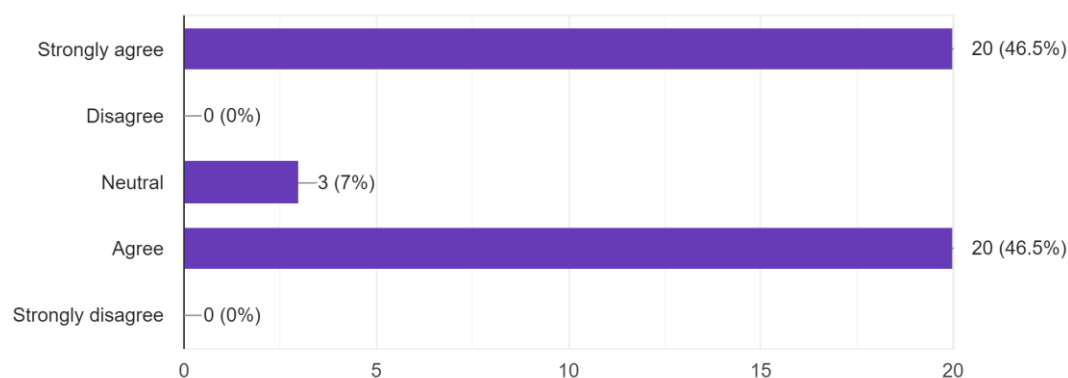

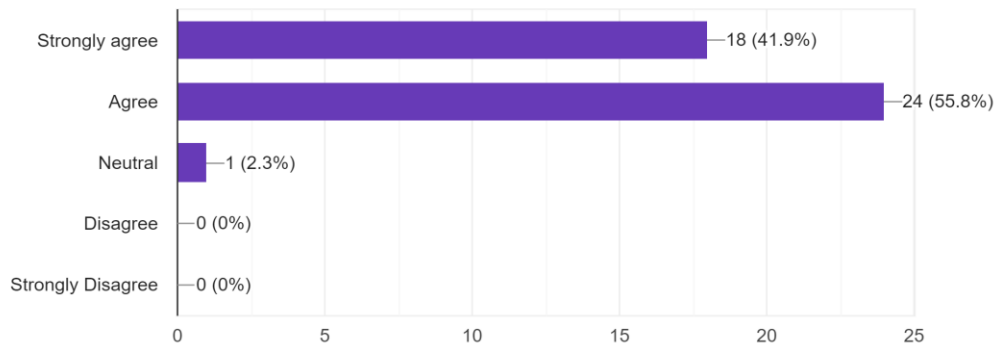

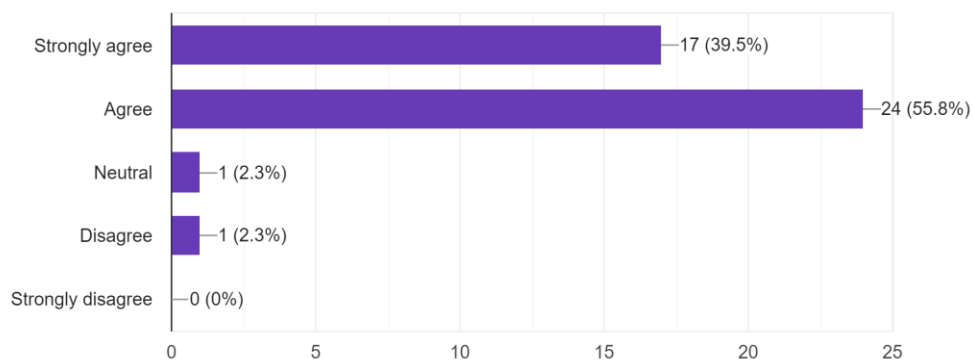

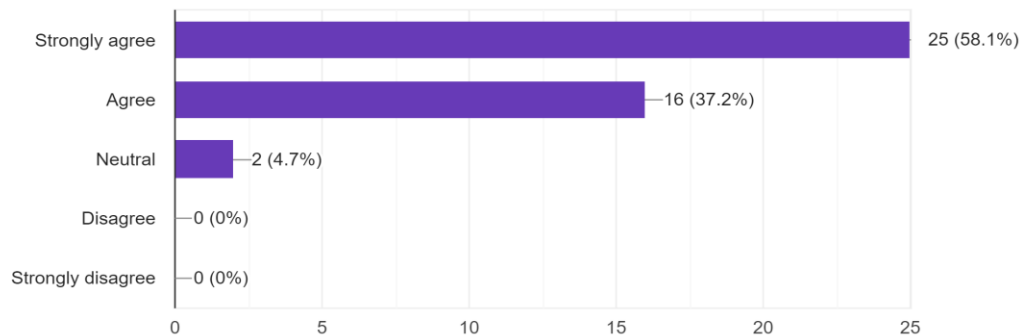

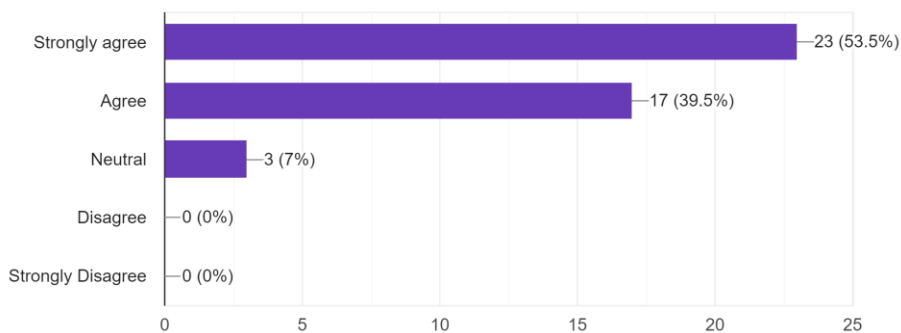

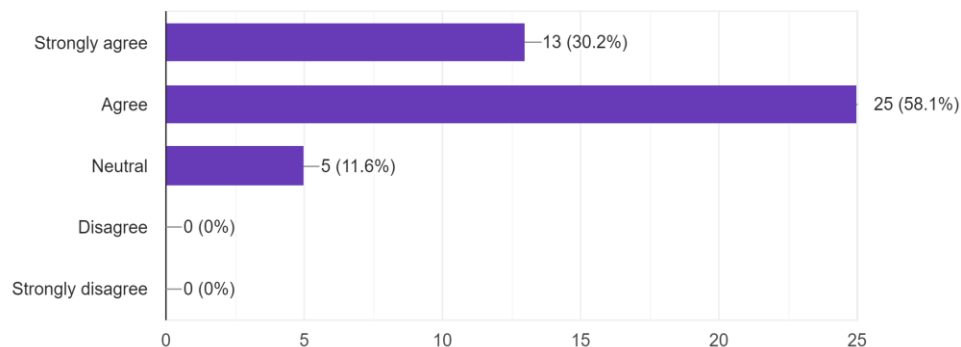

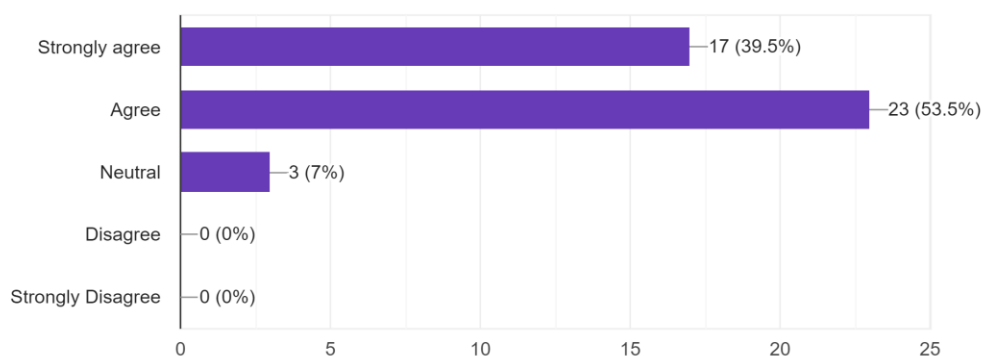

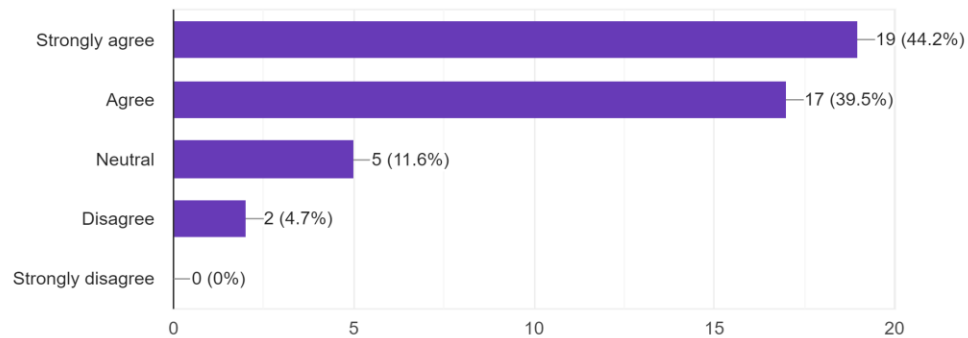

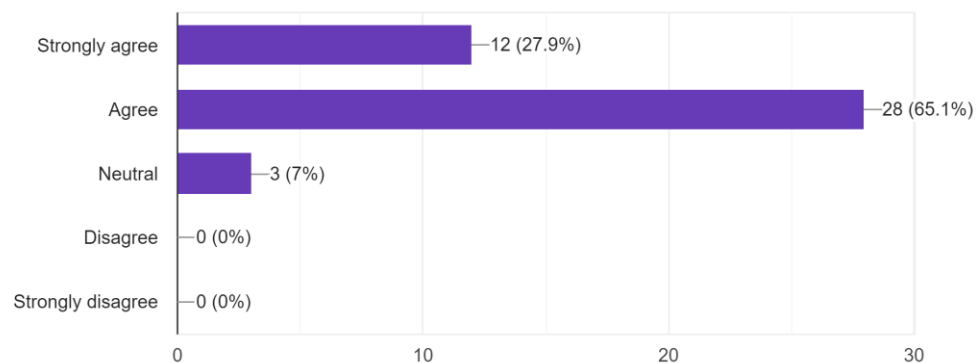

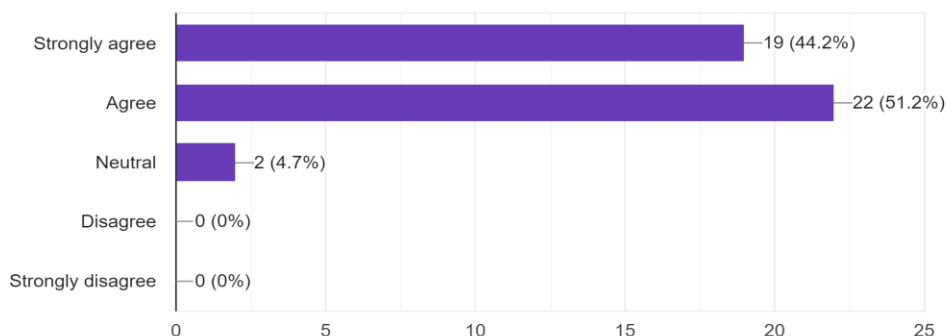

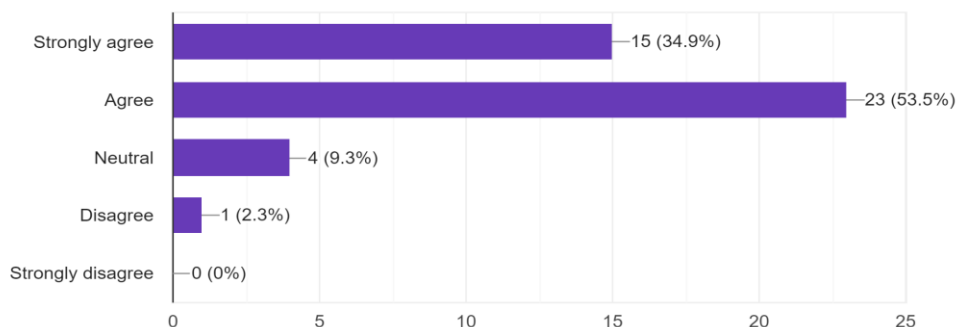

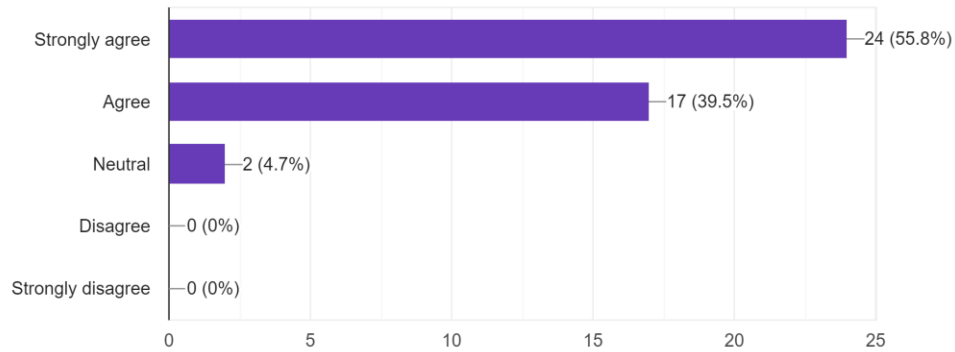

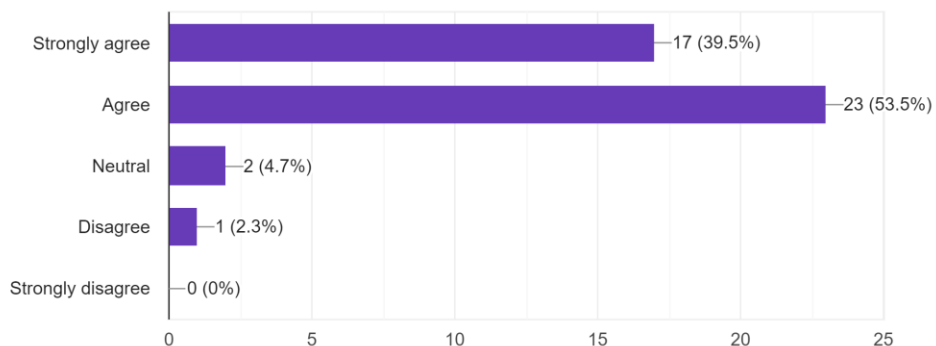

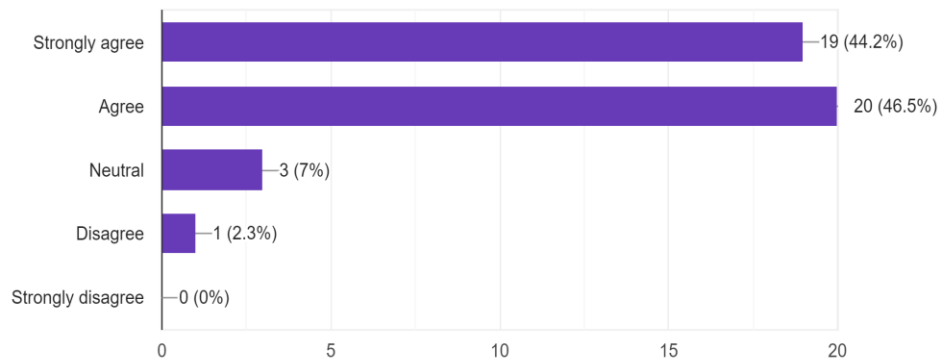

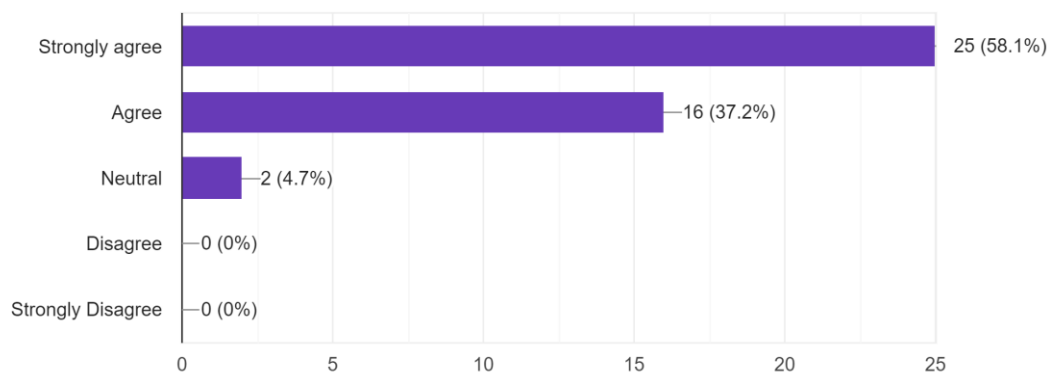

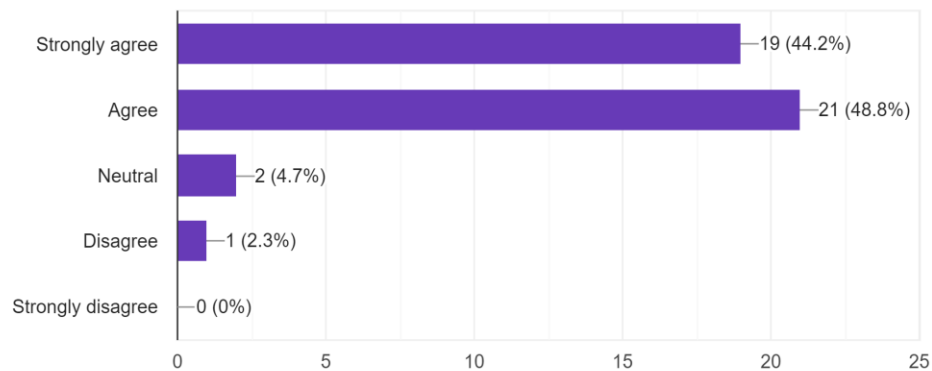

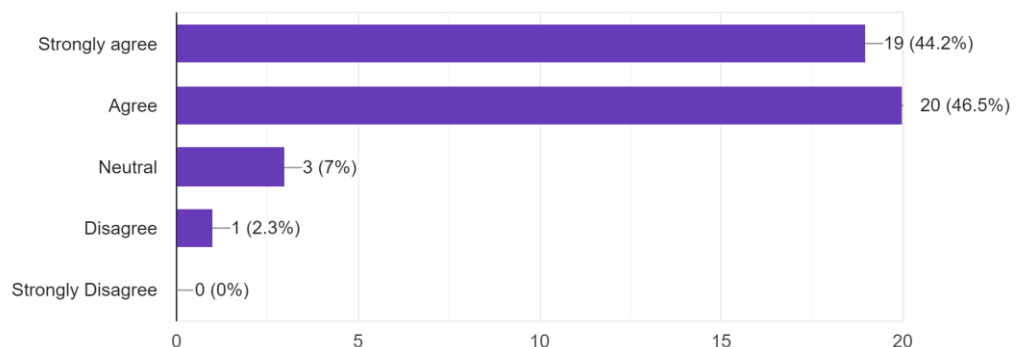

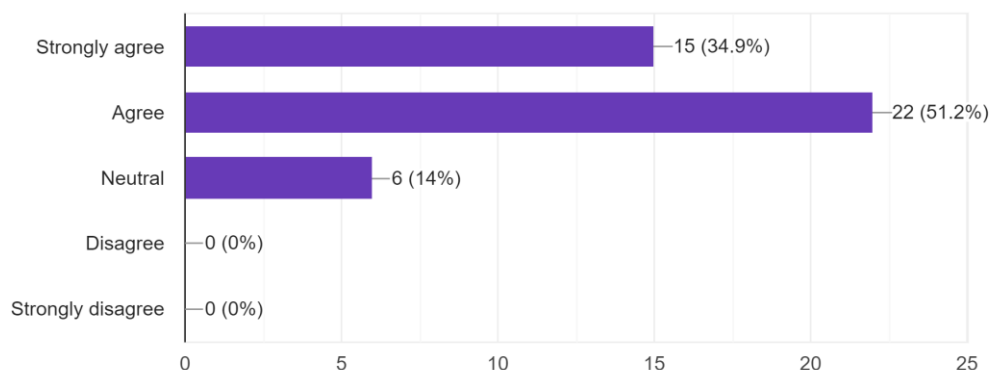

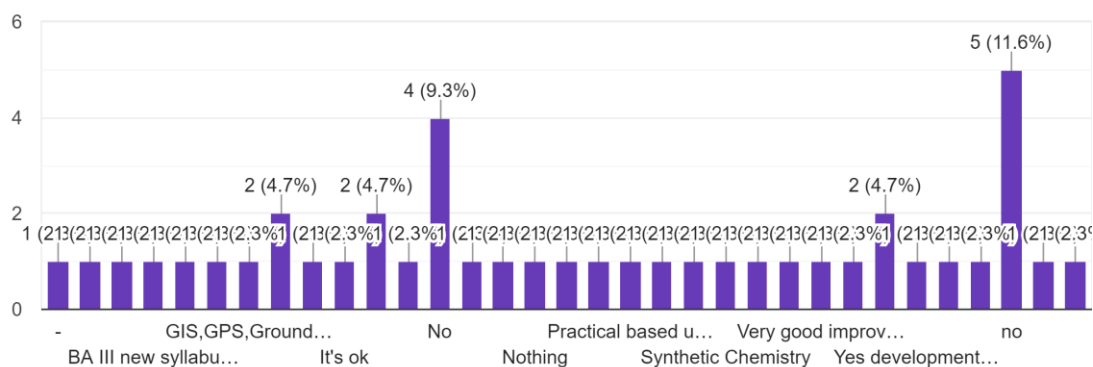

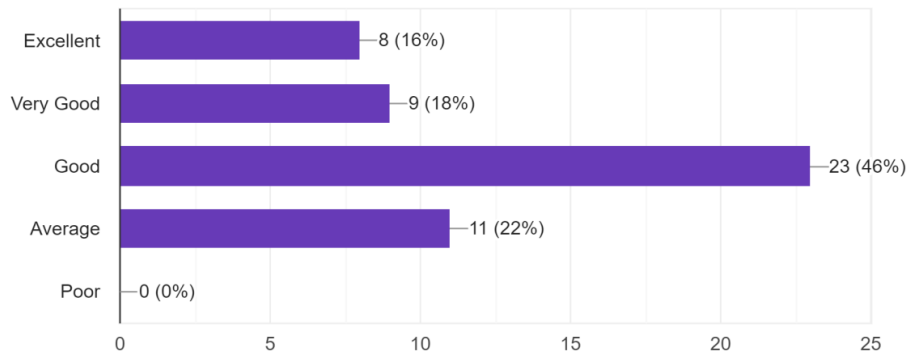


The feedback report shows that 36% students felt that Admission process is excellent while 28% of the students felt it is very good and 34% of the students felt good.

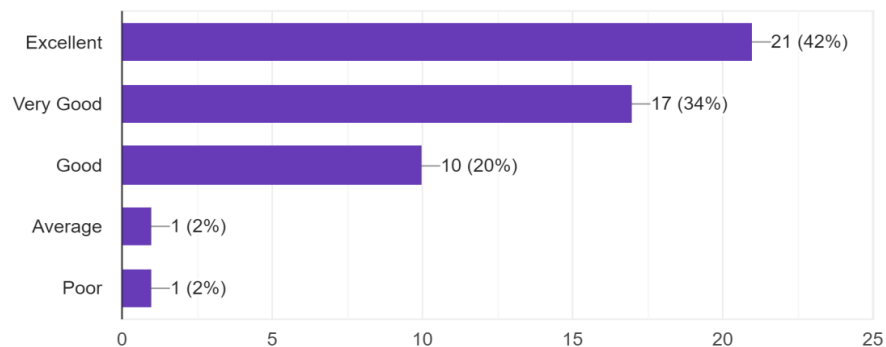

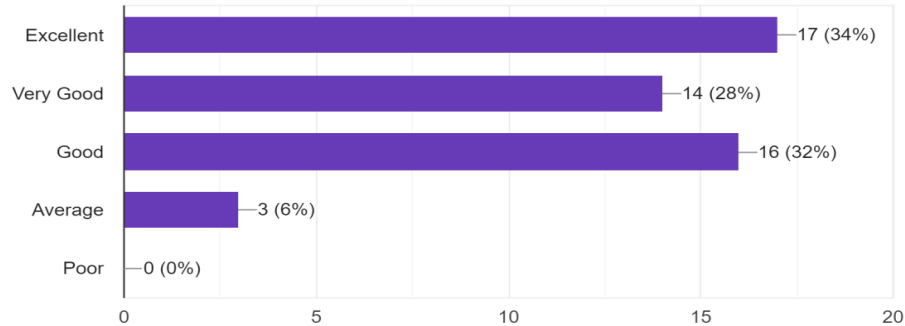

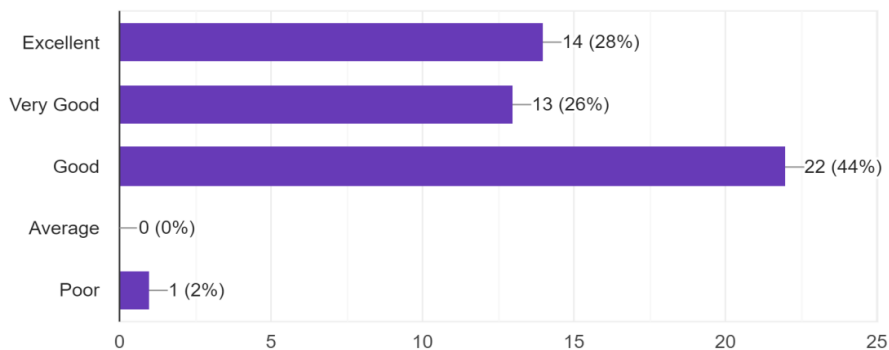

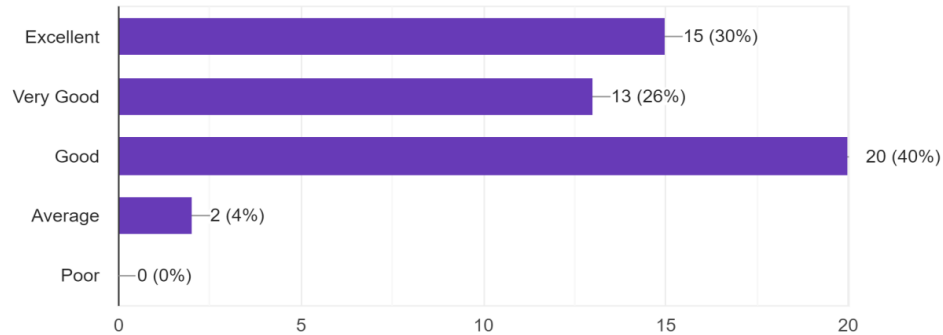

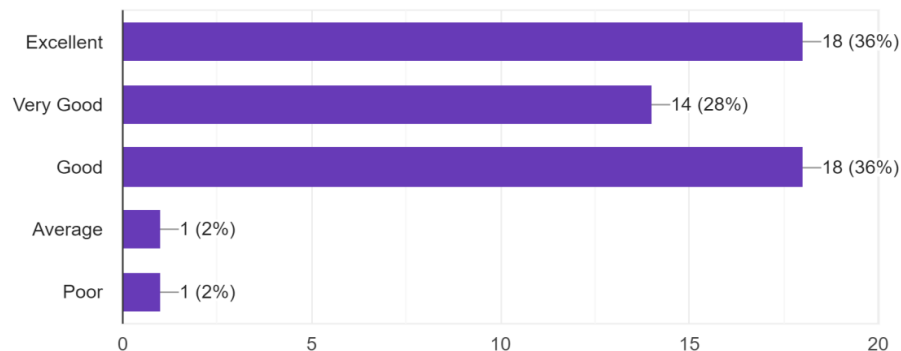

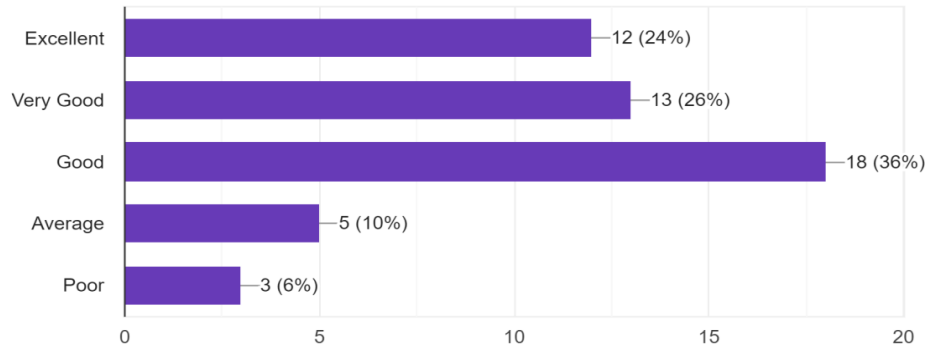

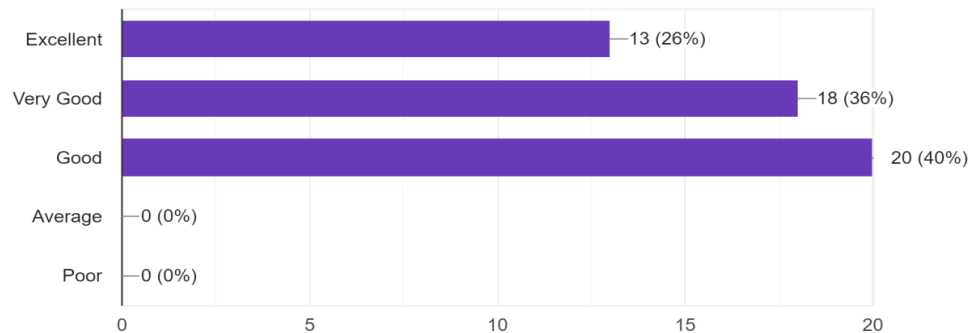

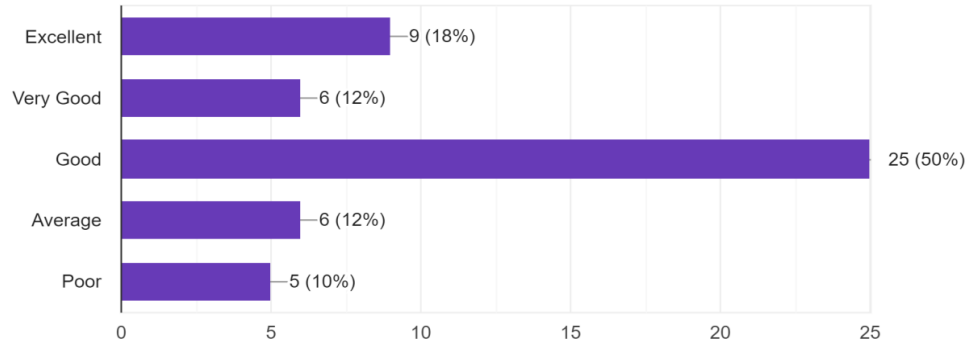

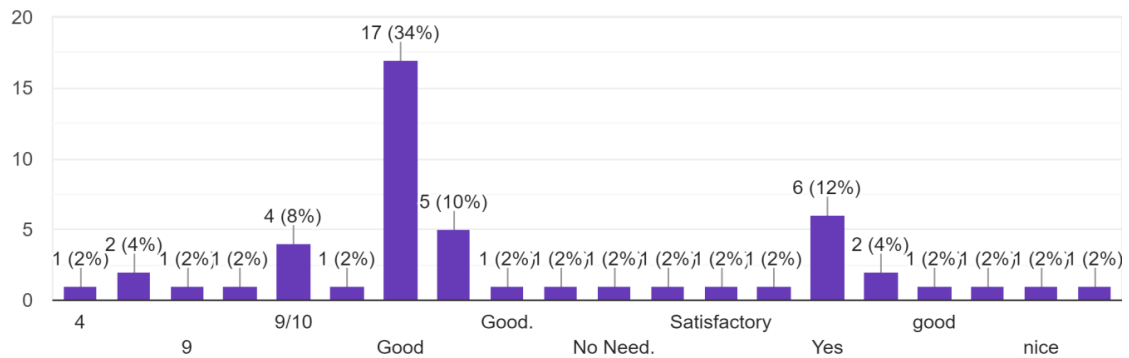

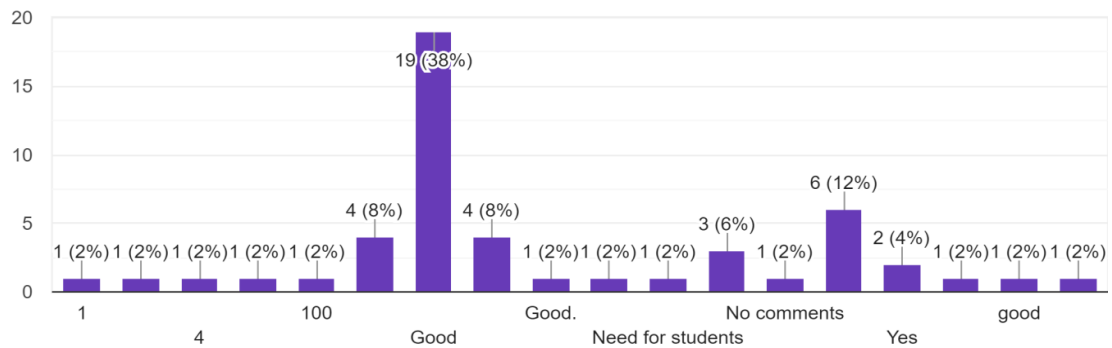

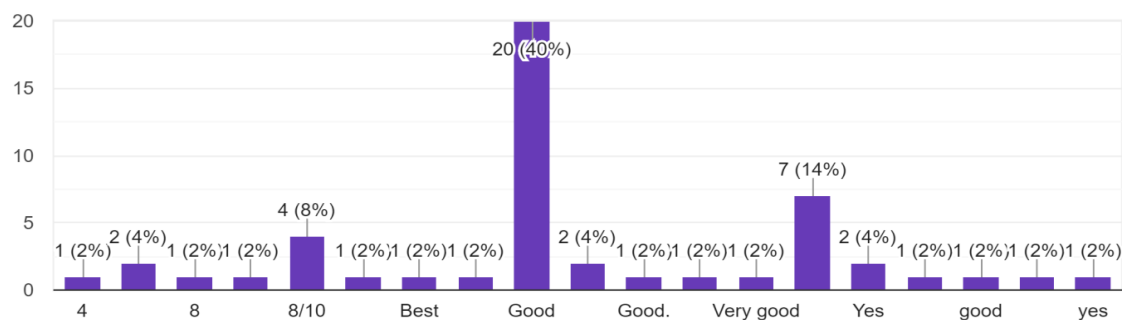

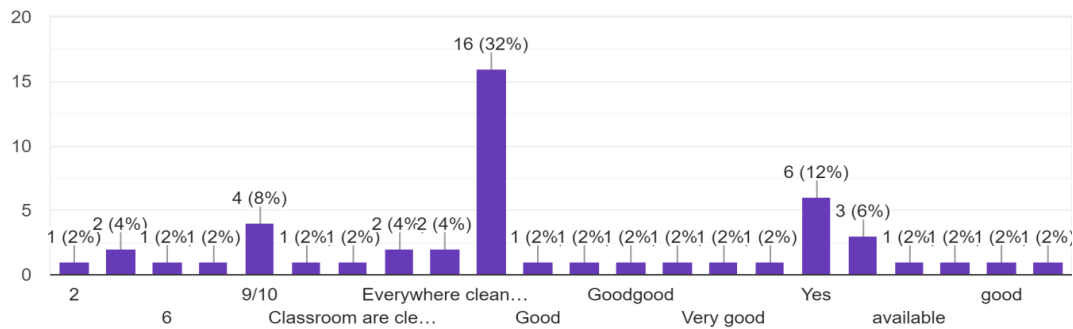

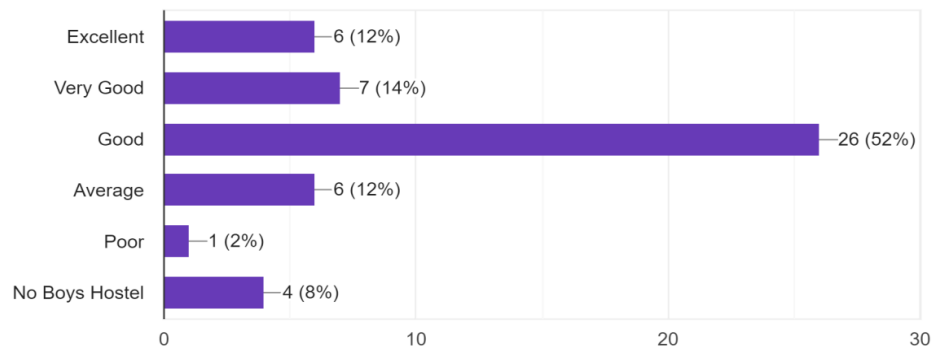

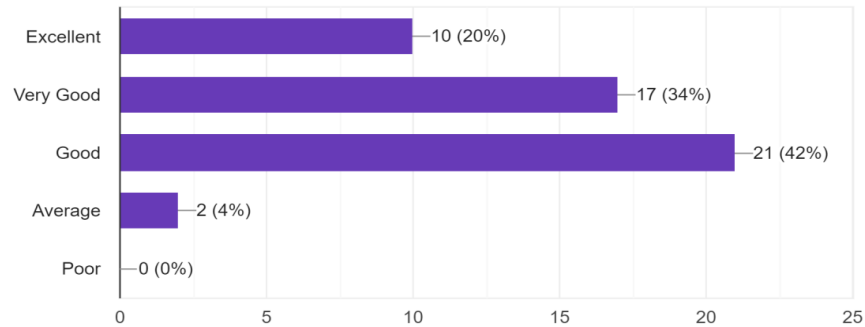

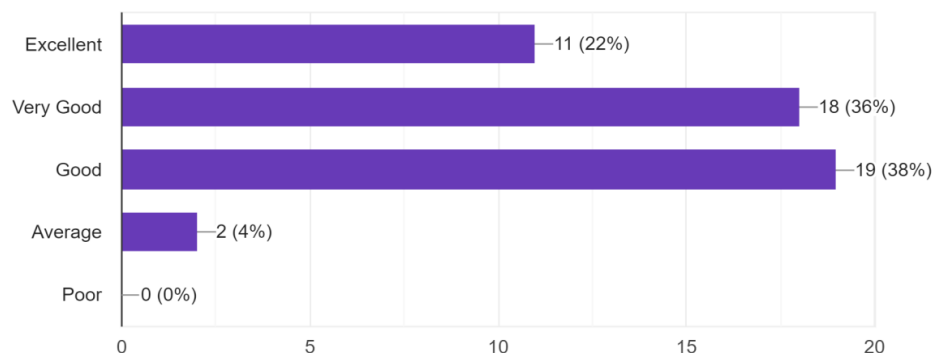

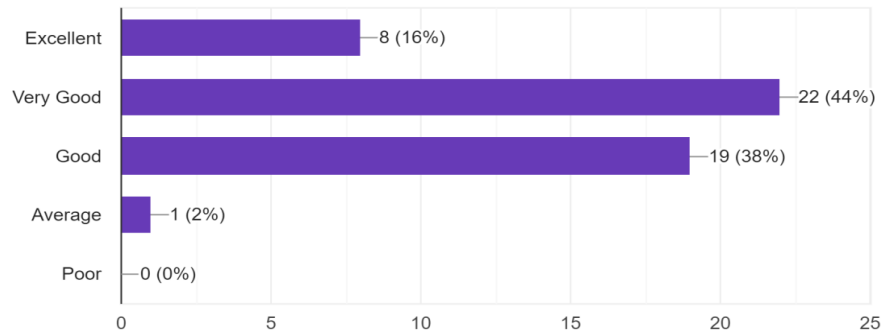

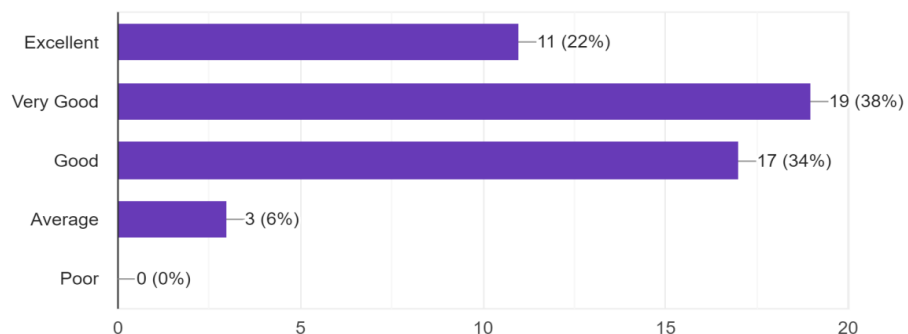

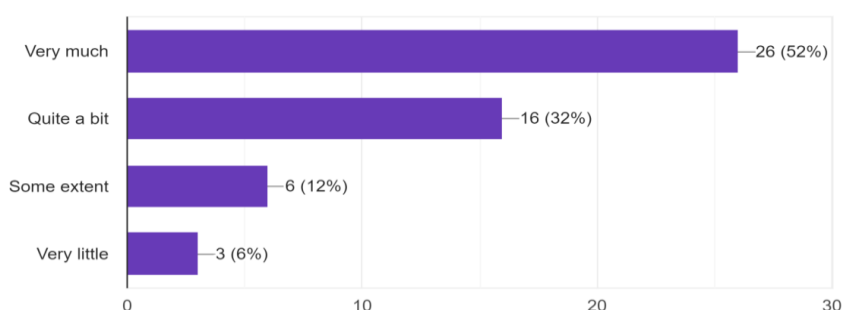

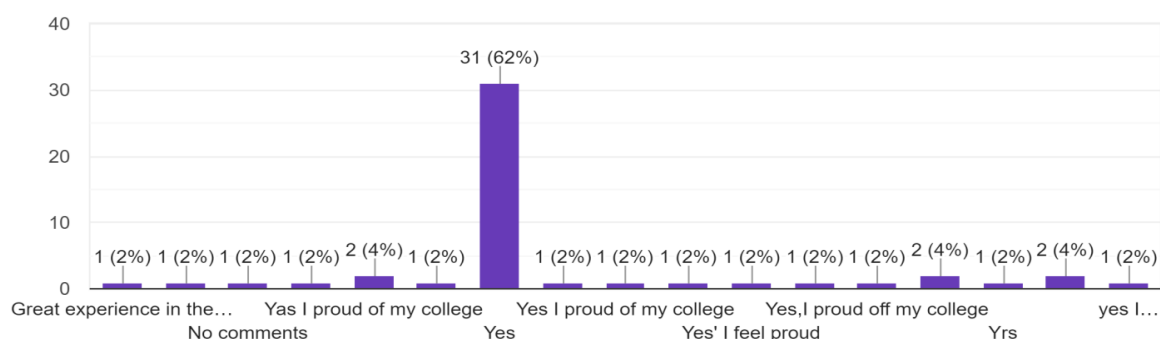

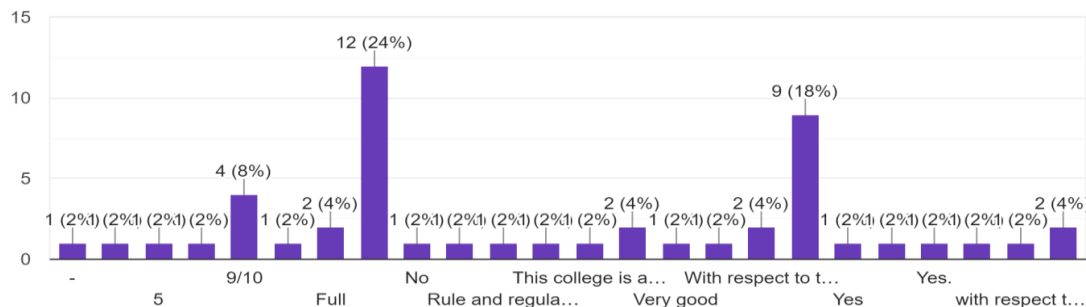

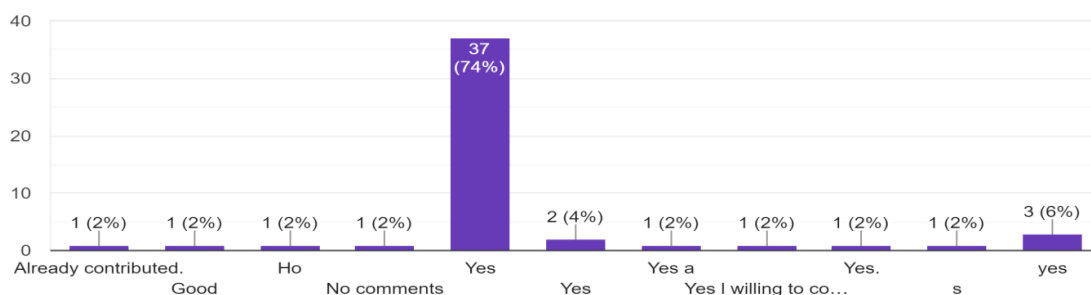

3. Are you willing to contribute to the development of the college?

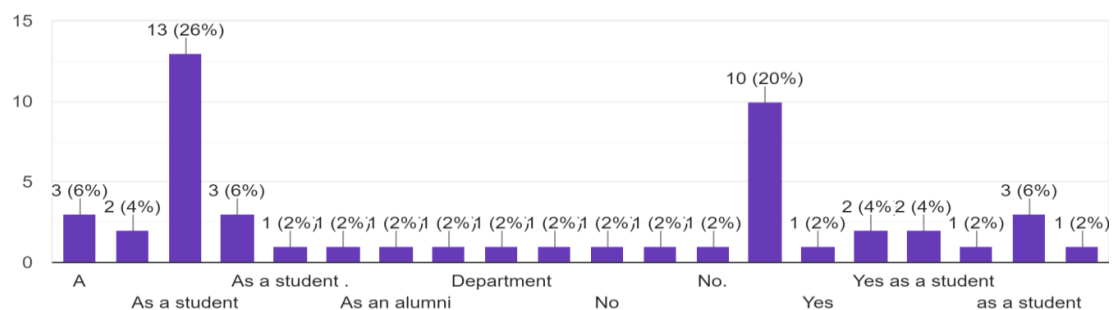

Opinions of the students about Grievances/problems handled by the Department / College, a) as a student b) as an Alumni:

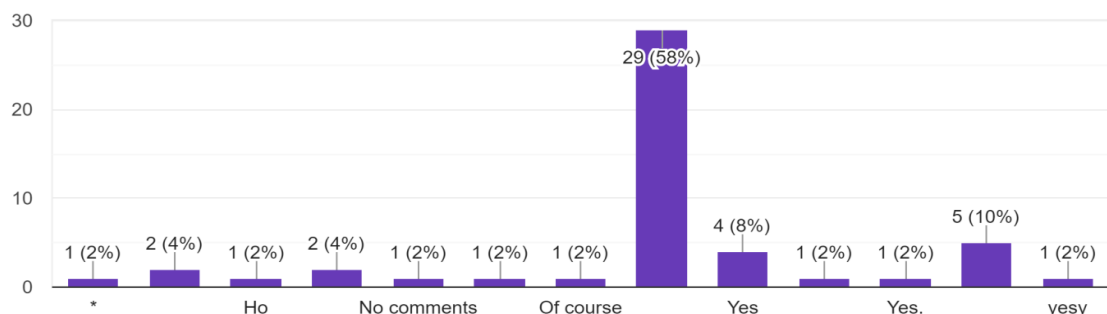
4. Where/Are your grievances properly handled at the Department/college? (a)
