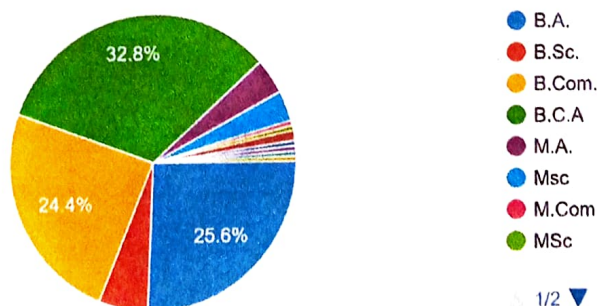
Introduction and Objectives:

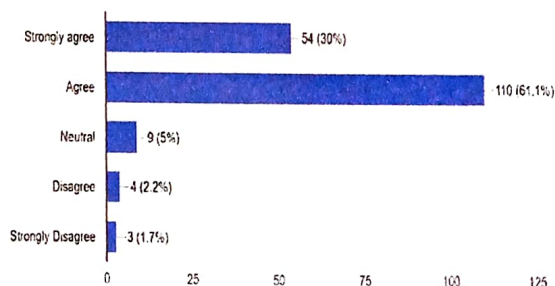

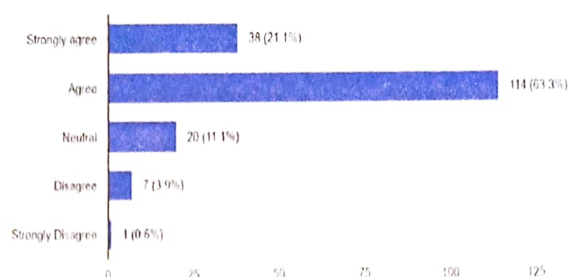

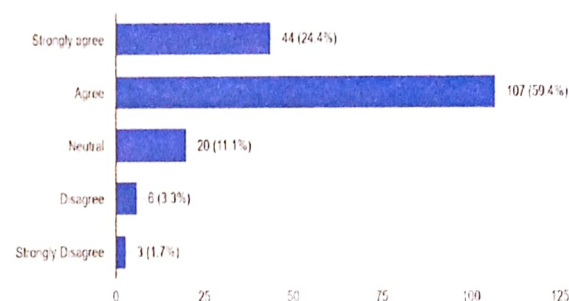

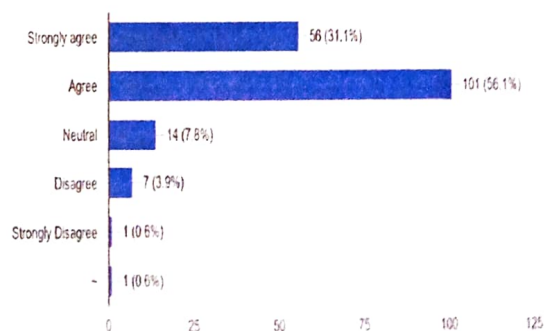

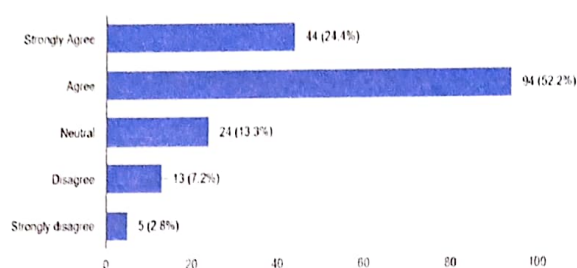

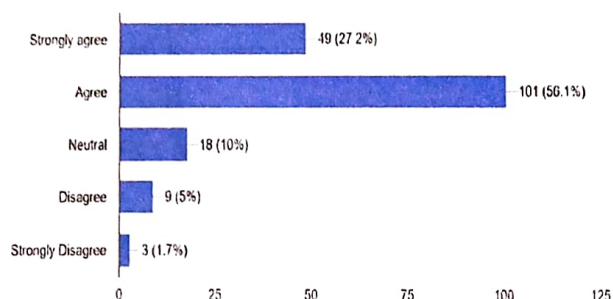

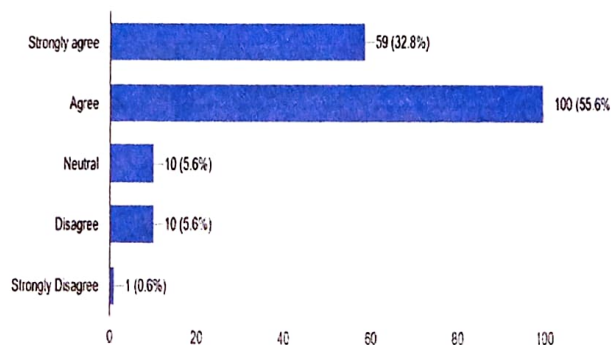

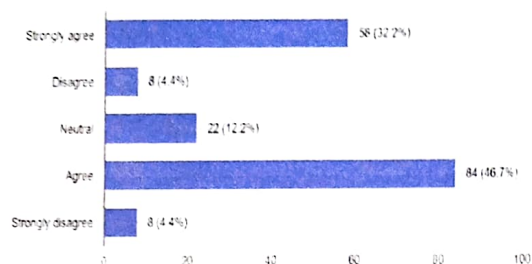


8. The office staffs in the College are helpful.

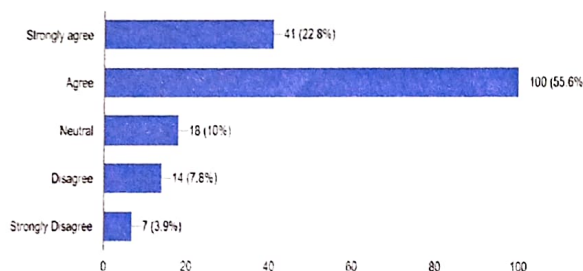


9. Toilets/washrooms are hygienic and properly.

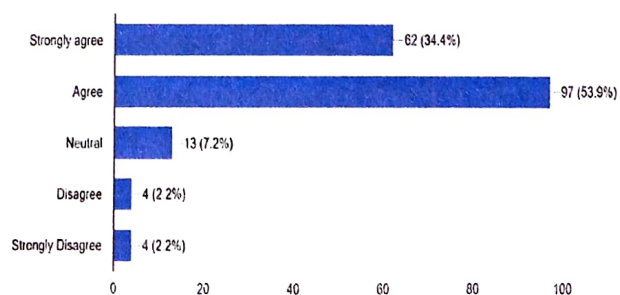


10. Drinking water is available on the campus.

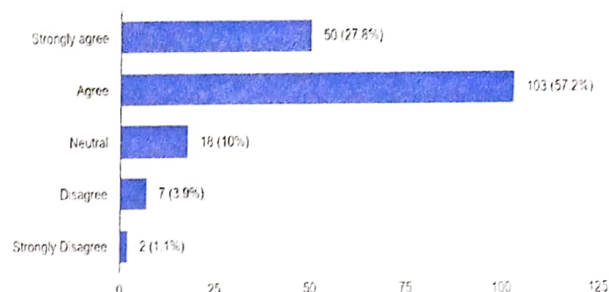


11. Grievances/problems redressed/solved well in time.

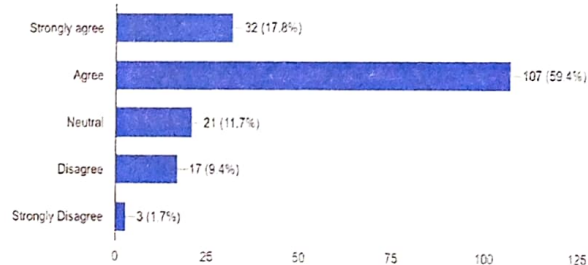


12. The functioning of the placement cell(s) in the College is satisfactory.

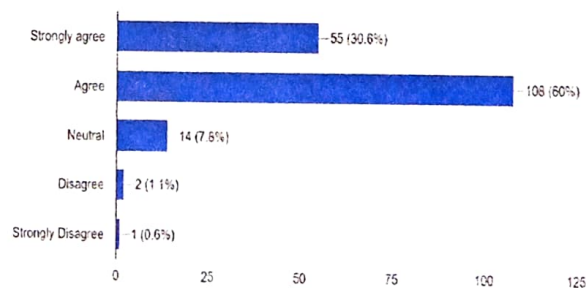


13. Equipment in the lab(s) are in working condition.

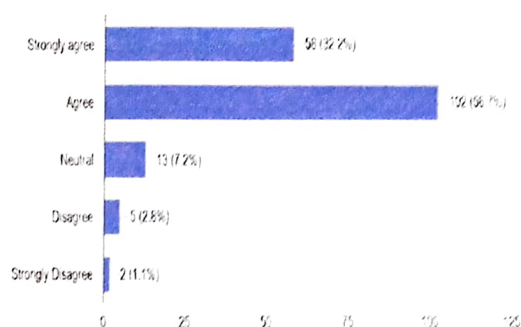


14. The campus is green and Eco-friendly

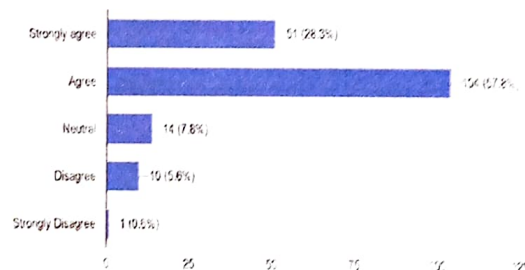


15. The buildings/classrooms are accessible to differently-abled students.

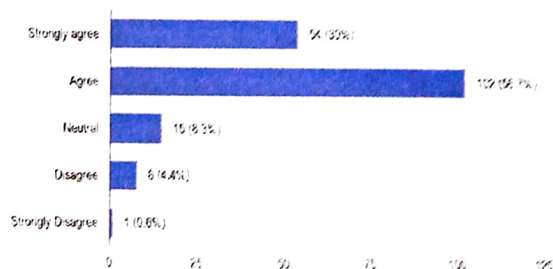


16. The classrooms are clean and well maintained.

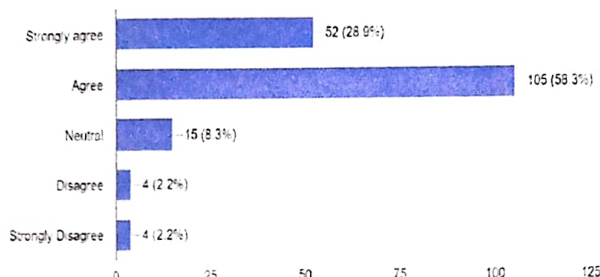

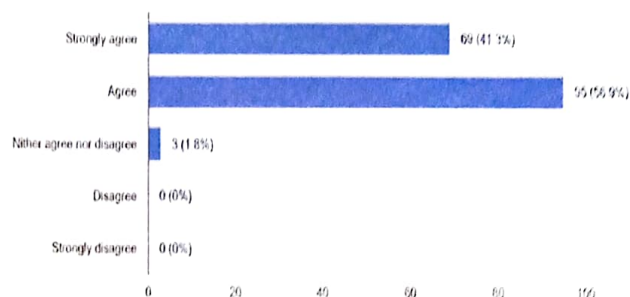

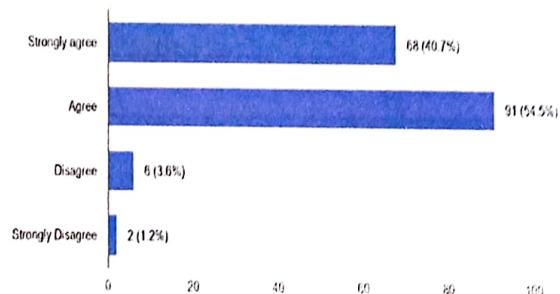

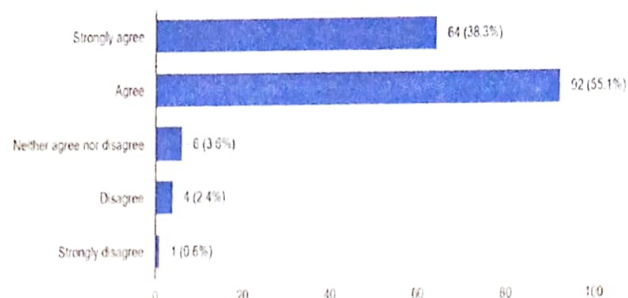

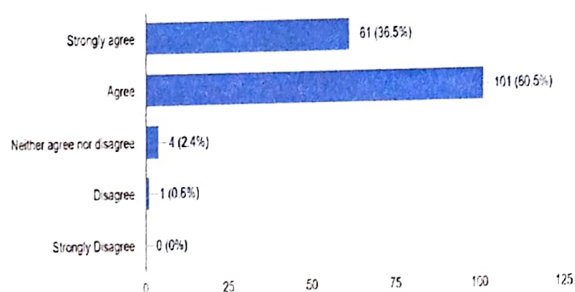

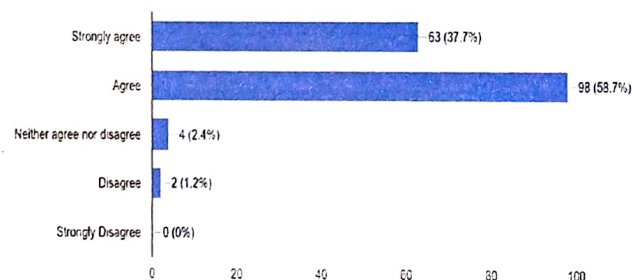

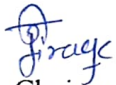
The respondents are agreeing with 94.6% for the teacher uses modern teaching aids, handout, suitable references, power point presentation, web resources, with 93.4% for the

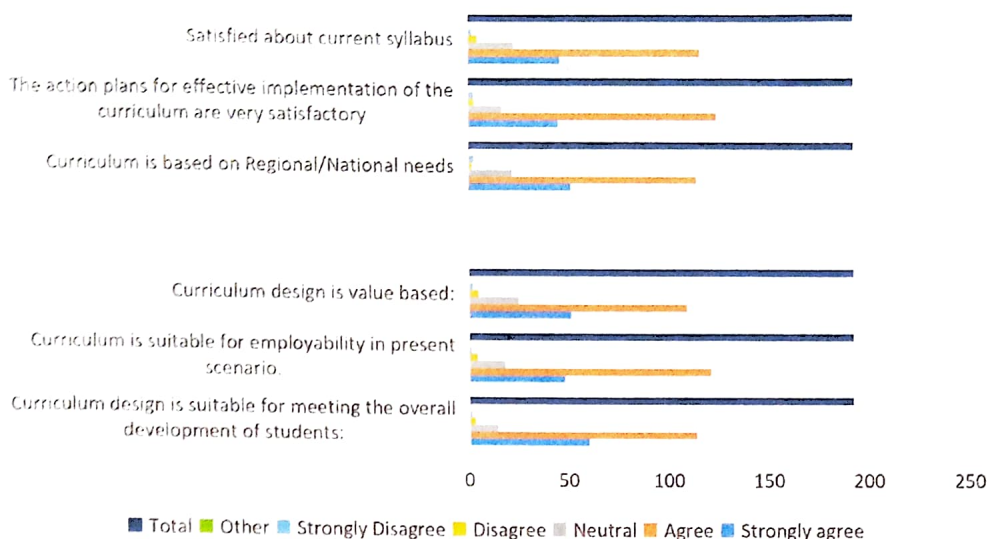

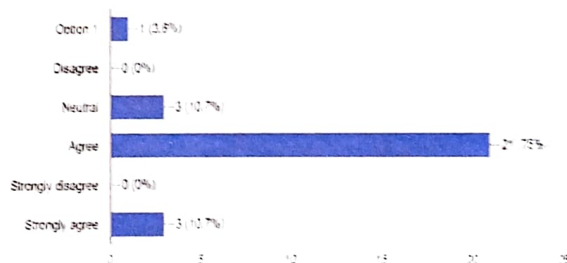

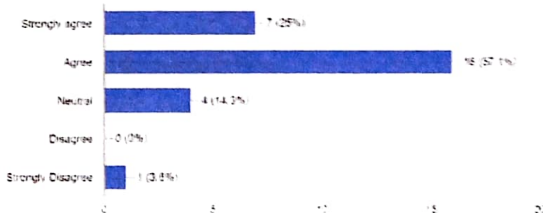

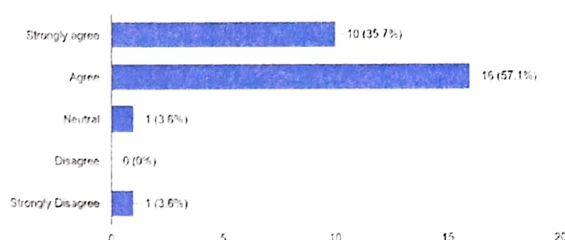

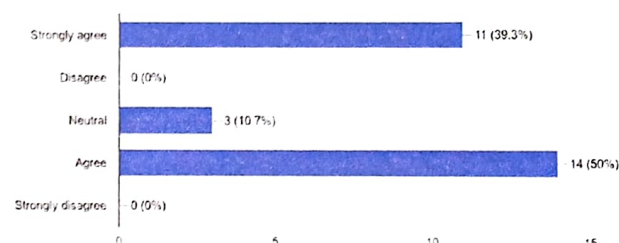

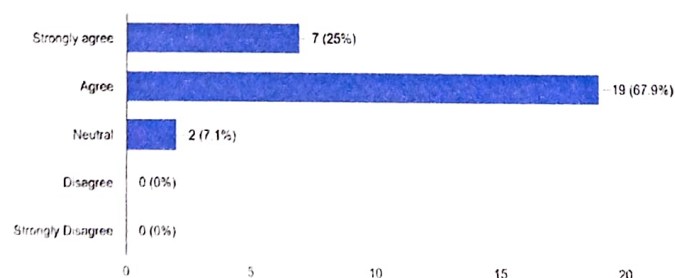

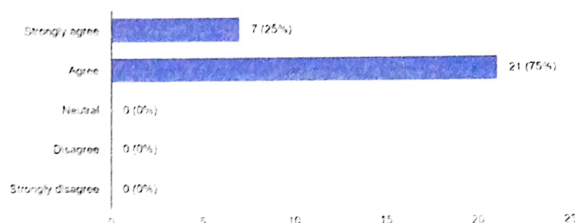

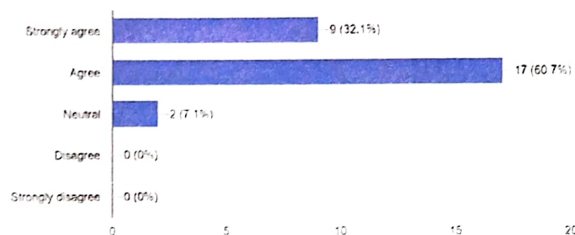

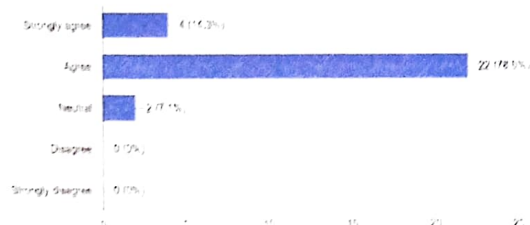

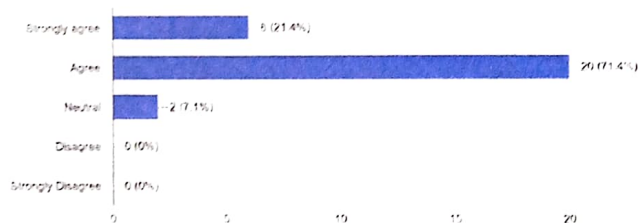

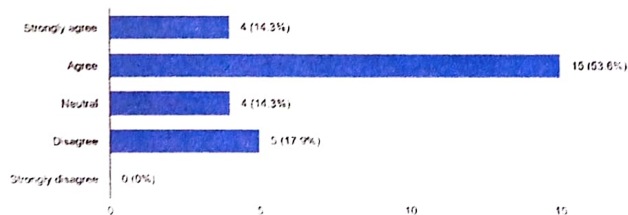

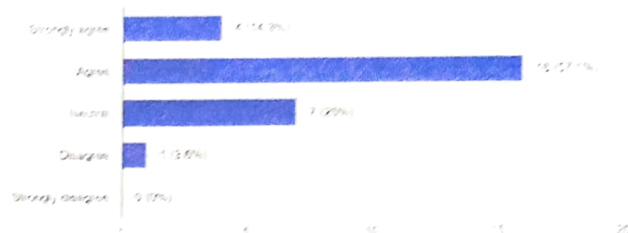

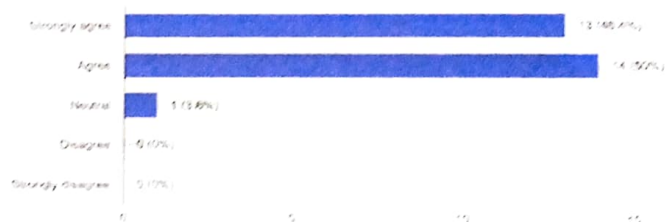

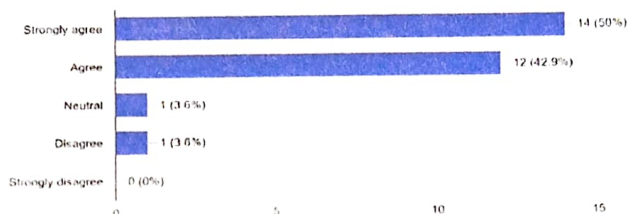

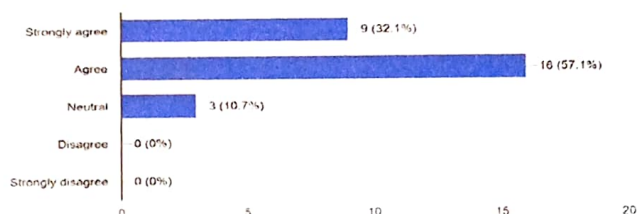

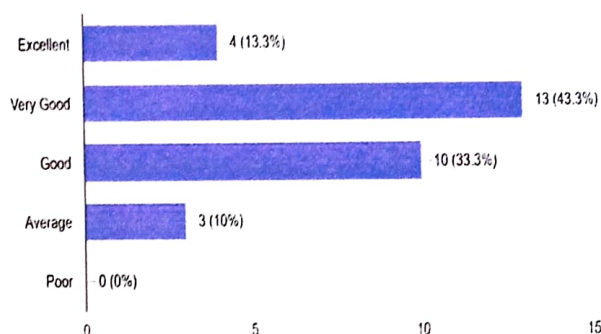

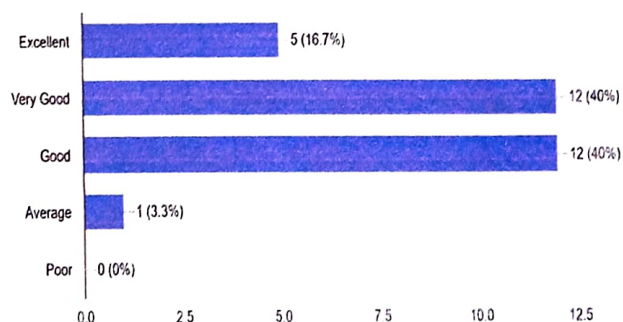

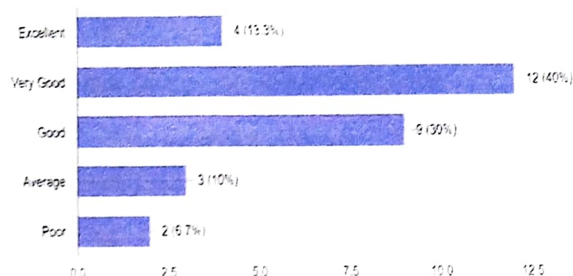

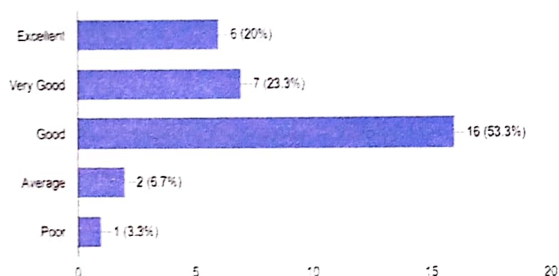

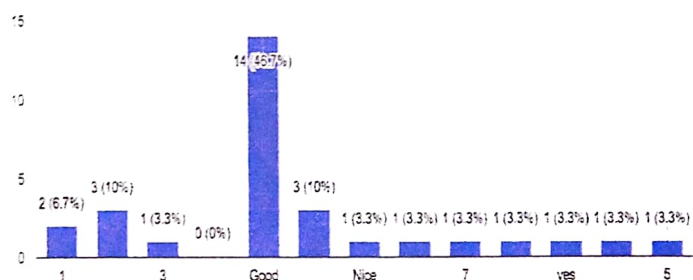

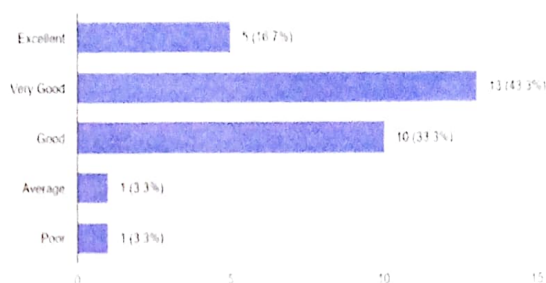

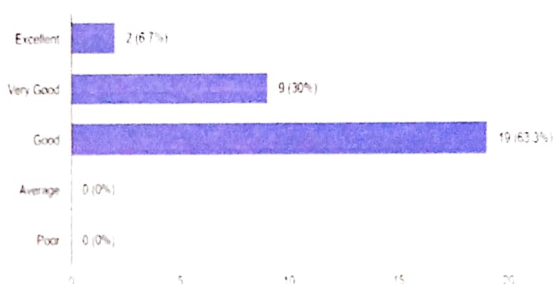

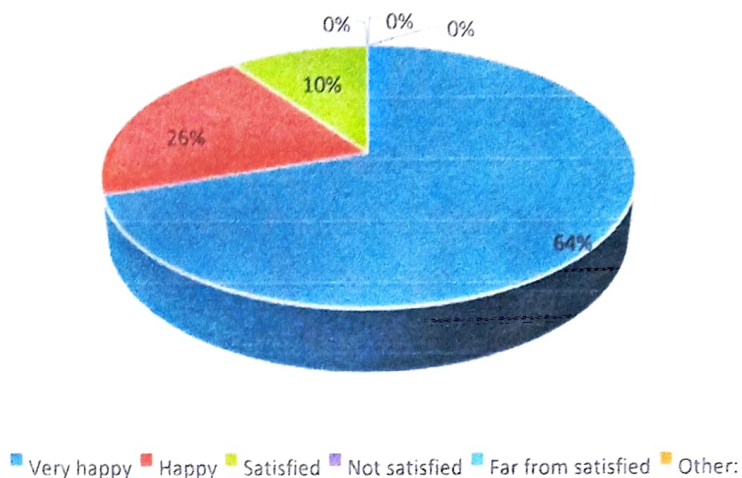

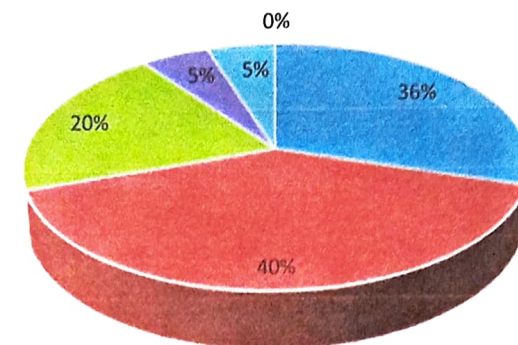

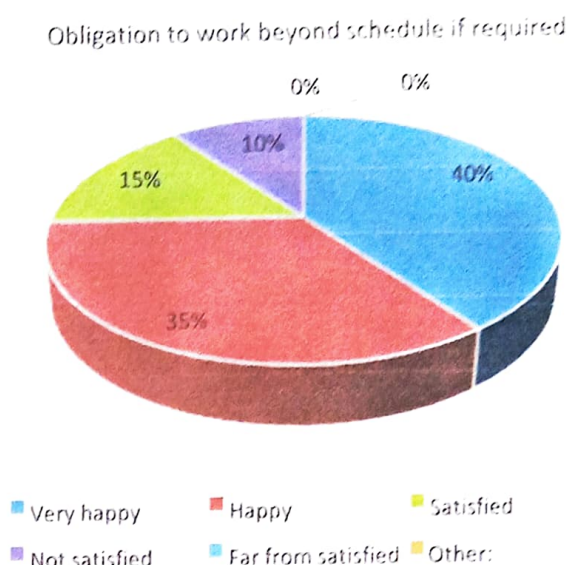
