Policy for the Institutional Scholarship:

Introduction:

The Government of India and Maharashtra government under the ministry of social justice and welfare a provide variety of different scholarships which are based on the category of the students, and the other merit scholarships provided by the government and universities have stringent selection criteria, so the majority of college students who are good in academics, sports and NCC, and NSS remain devoid of economic help. So the decision to institutional scholarships to meritorious student has been taken by the college.

The name of the scholarship is as per the suggested subject by philanthropies.

Allotment of Scholarship:

While receiving seed money for institutional scholarships from various philanthropies, the institution offers him a selection of subjects to which the scholarship is been provided. The meritorious students from the subject are offered the said scholarship. Simultaneously, to increase the number of philanthropists to donate seeds many for the scholarship. The college

also offers to name the scholarship in memory of relatives of philanthropies similarly donors were also identified to donate money for providing scholarship to the students from N.C.C., N.S.S and Sports, and Library Department.

Selection Process of student:

The selection of students for various institutional scholarship is carried out purely on Shivaji University examination results. The different students from the different subjects which receives maximum marks in the subject, their name and copy of the University result was received from various academic different heads. Similarly, the best candidate from N.C.C., N.S.S and Sports, and Library Department their names were also collected from these extension service departments. After scrutinizing various from the different department, the final list of selected candidates is prepared by the intuitional scholarship committee.

Distribution of Scholarship:

The seed money provided by philanthropists was kept in a bank. Few members allow the use of interest to be utilized as scholarship money as Fix deposit. Out of its interest, some money is used as a scholarship other money is added to the principal amount so that the value of fix deposit increases. The few philanthropists directly gave cash before scholarship distribution. All collected amounts as per selected subjects and amount disposed over to the students. The Scholarship is given to students in the prize distribution ceremony. Every year the distribution of scholarships is carried out to that money is directly given to the student's college meritorious students.
